

ARTSTOR is a database of hundreds of thousands of digital images.

- At the Library web site, select **Articles & Newspapers** (left column), then **ARTstor**.
- When in ARTstor, click **GO**, then **register** with your email address and create a password.
 - This allows you to save images to groups you create, and access them whenever you're in ARTstor.
- To use ArtStor **off-campus**, you must **first** access ARTstor from **on-campus** and **register** for an account.

6. To **save** an image to an **image group**:

- **Single-click** on an image to select it (image border changes to yellow), then **right-click** on image for save/append to groups choices.

Save selected images to new group

Append selected images to existing group

Append to recently opened group

- **Or**, select **Image Groups** at the top of the page.

- The first letter(s) of a book's **call number** is a clue to its subject.

Dictionary of Graphic Design and Designers **Ref. NC997 .L54 2003**

- Use a book's **index** to find "hidden" information and discover other terminology.
