

Literature Citations Using CSE Style Sample Citations

Book

Author(s) or editors(s) (last name first). Year. Title. Place of publication: publisher name. Number of pages.

Example:

Voet D, Voet JG. 1990. Biochemistry. New York: J Wiley. 1223 p.

Chapter in a Book

Author(s). Year. Title of book. Place of publication: publisher name. Chapter or section title; pages.

Example:

Singleton P, Sainsbury D. 1987. Dictionary of microbiology and molecular biology. 2nd ed. New York: J Wiley. Plasmid; p 682-3.

Magazines (non-scholarly)

Author(s). Date of publication. Article Title. Magazine title: page numbers.

Example:

Lu R. 1993 September. A small revelation: Newton has arrived at long last. Macworld: 102-6.

Newspaper article

Author(s). Date of publication. Article title. Newspaper title; section: page number (column number).

Example:

Rensberger B, Specter B. 1989 Aug 7. CFCs may be destroyed by natural process. Washington Post; Sect A:2(col 5).

Unsigned newspaper article example:

[Anonymous]. 1990. Aug 24. Gene data may help fight colon cancer. Los Angeles Times; Sect A:4.

Scientific Journal (scholarly)

Author(s). Year. Article title. Journal title volume number (issue number):pages.

Example:

Steiner U, Klein J, Eiser E, Budkowski A, Fetters LJ. 1992. Complete wetting from polymer mixtures. Science 258:1122-9.

Technical Report

Author(s) (performing organization). Title. Place of publication: publisher or sponsoring organization. Report number. Contract number. Total number of pages. Availability statement.

Example:

National Institute of Health (US). 1988 Dec. Report of the Human Fetal Tissue Transplant Panel, consultants to the Advisory Committee to the Director, NIH. Final Report. Bethesda (MD):NIH. 2 volumes. Available from NTIS, Springfield, VA, PB90-155268, PB90-155276.

In other words, give as much information as possible to find this report!

Personal Communication

Author. Author's title and where to reach him. Date. Personal communication.

Example:

Jones, MR. Director of Research, Smith College Biology Department. 28 February 2000. Personal communication.

Web Sources

Author(s). Date of publication. Title of article. Sponsoring website. Most recent date of revision of website. <http://address> (date you visited the site).

Example:

Burke, LP. "Decline of Salmon in the Pacific Northwest." EPA. 1997. <http://www.epa.usgov.envisissues/essay/> (28 Feb. 00).

Videocassette

Author(s) or editor(s) or any combination of these. Date of publication. Title [videocassette]. Producer (if different from publisher). Place of publication: publisher. Physical description (length of tape, color/b&w).

Example:

Wood RM, editor. 1989. New horizons in esthetic dentistry [videocassette]. Visualeyes Productions, producer. Chicago: Chicago Dental Society. 2 videocassettes. 170 min, color.
