

1. Vocabulary Review:

- a. **URL:** Uniform Resource Locator. The **web address**. For example:
<http://www.clark.edu/Library>
- b. **Browser** (Internet Explorer): Computer software that allows you to look at web pages.
- c. **Home Page:** Any page you set your browser to show first. It might be a page you create yourself. At Cannell Library, our Home Page is the **Cannell Library Home Page:** www.clark.edu/Library
- d. **Web Site:** A collection of web pages related to a topic, company, organization or person. A web site has a home page and other pages.
- e. **Link:** Words that you click on to take you to another Web page or site. These links are usually underlined or in a different color.
- f. **Search Engine:** Software used to find things on the web. For example, **Google** or **Yahoo**.
- g. **More vocabulary:** software, hardware, html, internet, WWW, domain name, html, ISP

- c. How did the city get its name?

3. Google: www.google.com

- a. Choose **Images** in Google. Find a picture of your home town or country.
