

General Information:

- ❑ Start your research from the Library Web Page: www.clark.edu/Library
- ❑ Get a Library Card at the Check Out desk
- ❑ Citing Sources: From the left navigation bar on the library home page, select → **Citing Sources**. Then select the style (Chicago, MLA, etc.)
- ❑ Interlibrary Loan (Start early - it can take 2 weeks to receive materials)

Reference Collection & Subject Encyclopedias:

Browse the N – NX sections of the Reference Collection.

Everyone should start with this source! Look up your topic in the index in Vol. 34.

Books: Online Catalogs (left bar on the library home page, Books →)

- ❑ **Cannell Library Book Catalog:** www.clark.edu/Library
- ❑ **PORTALS Library Catalogs:** Search other area academic libraries in the Portland area.
- ❑ **Summit:** Search the combined catalog of 30+ libraries in Washington and Oregon.
- ❑ **WORLDCAT:** Search 35 million resources in the United States and worldwide. Once you locate a book, use Interlibrary Loan to obtain it.

Periodical Indexes: Use to find articles in magazines and journals:

- ❑ **InfoTrac OneFile:** (1980-present) Cannell Library web page
- ❑ **ProQuest:** (early 1980s-present) Cannell Library web page
- ❑ **Art Index:** Cannell owns the print version from 1950-1976. The Portland State University Library (and others) owns this index in electronic format.

World Wide Web:

- ❑ Good place to start: From the left bar on the library home page, select Search the Web → Art. Browse the links.
