Contemporary Authors: Autobiography Series (Ref PN453.C63)

Contemporary Authors: New Revision Series (Ref Z1224.C62)

A good starting point for information on authors who have gained prominence in the last 20 years. Extensive and recent biographies are included with each author. Begin by using the **Contemporary Authors Cumulative Index** (Ref Z1224.C6 and Ref Z1224.C62).

Dictionary of Literary Biography (Ref PS21.D5) This multi-volume series devotes each volume to writers of a specific genre or period. There is a cumulative index in the back of each volume.

American Writers

American Women Writers (Ref PS147.A4) 5 volumes. Essays on writers from all periods of American history.

American Writers (Ref PS129.A55) Originally 4 volumes, with 6 supplements added. Signed essays on writers from the colonial period to the present.

Black American Writers Past and Present (Ref Z1229.N39 R87) 2 volumes. Short biographies of over 2,000 African-American authors, living and deceased.

Oxford Companion to Women's Writing in the United States (Ref PS147.O94 1995) Biographies of famous and obscure authors who had an impact in the U.S.

International Writers

Author's and Writer's Who's Who (Ref Z2011.A91 1960) English-speaking writers, with some whose works have been translated into English. Brief profiles.

British Authors Before 1800: A Biographical Dictionary (Ref PR105.K9 1952) Looks at 650 British writers of both major and minor significance.

International Writers continued

British Writers (Ref PR85.B688) 10-volume set. Includes past and present authors.

Contemporary Women Poets (Ref PS151.C67 1998) Women poets from English-speaking countries.

Companion to African Literatures (Ref PR9340.C5 2000)

Contemporary Native American Authors (Ref PS153.I52 J87 1997)

European Authors, 1000-1900 (Ref PN451.K8 1967) Over 900 brief biographies.

European Writers: The Twentieth Century (Ref PN501.E9 1983) Extensive profiles of over 100 authors.

Greek and Latin Authors: 800 B.C. – A.D. 1000 (Ref PA31.G7) Good source of information on authors from the classical period.

Latin American Writers (Ref PQ7081.A1 L37 1989) 3 volumes. Over 170 signed biographies of authors from the late 1400s through the 1980s.

Nobel Laureates in Literature: A Biographical Dictionary (Ref 452.P7 1990) Information on every winner through 1988.

Oxford Companion to Children's Literature (Ref PN1008.5.C37 1984) Biographies of authors and illustrators of children's books, plus genres of children's literature.

Oxford Companion to Irish Literature (Ref PR8706.O88 1996)

Penguin Companion to Classical, Oriental and African Literature (Ref PA31.P4 1971) A good reference for Asian and African writers, primarily from the ancient period.
