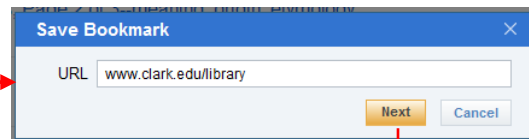
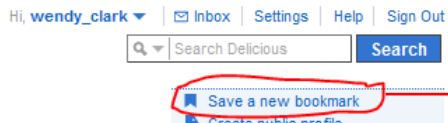
Find a website you want to remember? Save it as a bookmark! [Delicious](http://delicious.com) is a Social Bookmarking service, which means you can save all your bookmarks online, share them with other people, and see what other people are bookmarking. It was owned by **YAHOO!** but was just acquired by YouTube founders AVOS.

Join Now/Sign In

Sign in. You can link to your existing Yahoo! account or create a new account on delicious.com.

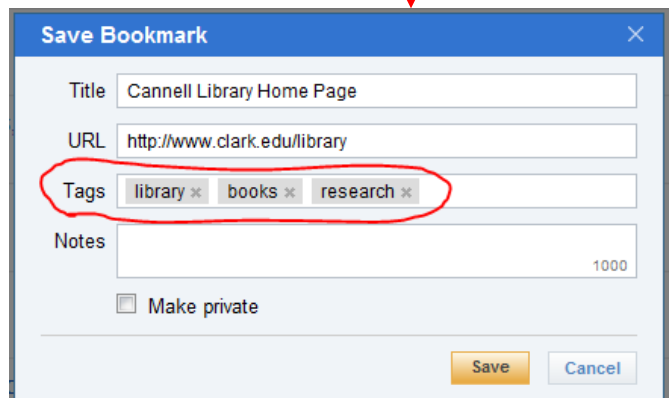
Save a website (bookmark)

Click on the **Save a new bookmark** link on the right top side of the screen. A new **Save Bookmark** screen will pop up. Paste or type the website address you want to save in the URL box and click **Next**.



The **Title** is taken from the website, but you can change that.

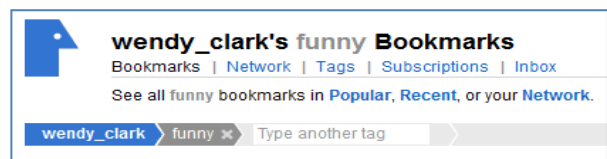
Type the **Tags** or categories that will remind you of this website later. Separate each tag with a space. If you want a tag that reads, "Very Cute," have to type it with no spaces: "verycute" or "very_cute" or "very-cute". **Tags make Delicious better than regular bookmarks! Use them!**



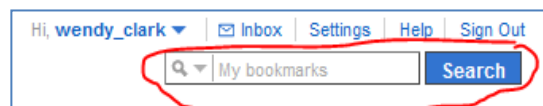
Click **Save**.

Find a website you bookmarked

Easiest: search by tag. You can enter multiple tags.



If you can't remember which tag(s) you used, you can search all of your bookmarks by keywords in the Title or Tags (not Notes).

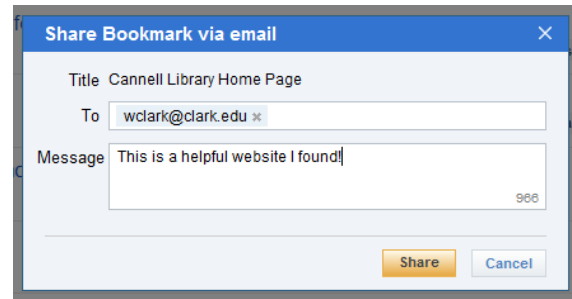


Share a website you bookmarked

Select the website from your bookmark list and click “Share”.

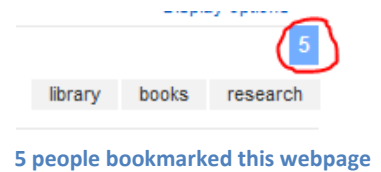

You can share via Twitter, email, or Delicious’s internal service (to other Delicious users only).

Social bookmarking

- See who else has bookmarked a webpage
- Search everyone’s bookmarks by tags or keywords
- Share websites with other Delicious users
- Join networks and send messages to users saving the same types of webpages as you
- Subscribe to a news feed so every time someone saves a webpage with a certain tag you can also view it.



Extras

Add-ons: Browser buttons save a bookmark to Delicious with one click. A beta version for Firefox 4 is available at <https://addons.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/addon/delicious-extension/>. For other browsers, I recommend <http://www.delicious.com/help/bookmarklets>.

Import/Exporting: (on the top right, click on **Settings**) Transfer your current browser’s bookmarks into Delicious. Backup your bookmarks as an file on your computer to put them back into one browser. You can also transfer your bookmarks into another online service like Google Bookmarks.
