



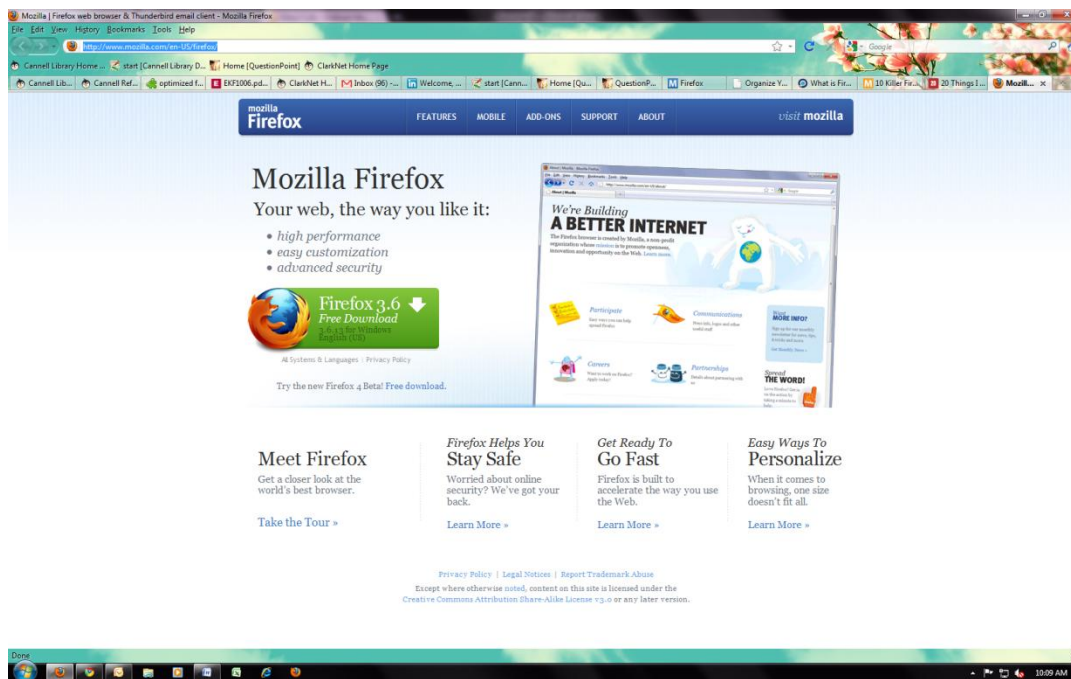

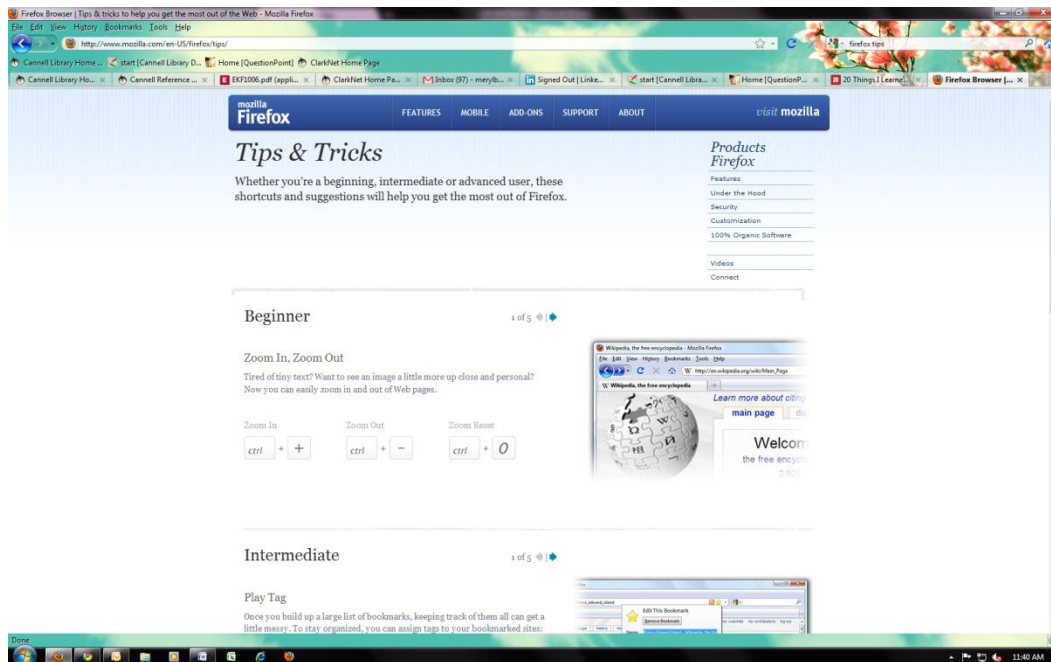
## Going Mobile
