Got an itch to create a Blog? Wanna Wallow in a Wiki? Afraid people will think you're just playing around? Thwart criticism (and keep on track) by starting with a plan.

What do you want the wiki or blog to do? (Outcomes)

example: I want to build a wiki to collaborate on a definitive list of mystery series.

What will be happening? (Indicators/Activities)

example: my colleagues and I will contribute content; we'll post a link on the website and publicize the wiki. We'll log in and add titles and authors at least 3-4 times a week.

How will you gather your data or evidence? (Assessments/Performance Criteria)

example: Monitor site statistics, monitor growth and currency.

Timeline: How often will you gather/analyze assessments?

example: We'll monitor progress quarterly and report in the quarterly reports.
