



30 Clicks: Prezi
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Prezi is an online presentation tool that lets you create presentations on any computer with Internet access.

Getting Started

- 1) Go to: <http://prezi.com>
- 2) Click on the “Sign Up Now” button
- 3) Choose to register for:
 - a. Public option (with any e-mail account)
 - b. Student/Teacher option (with a school e-mail account)
- 4) Type in your name, e-mail address and password



Creating a Prezi Presentation

- 1) Click on “New Prezi” button
- 2) Enter a title and description for your presentation
- 3) Begin typing your ideas on the Prezi wall

Use the Zebra tool to:

- 1) Move text around
- 2) Change text size
- 3) Rotate your text



Use the Circle tool to:

- 1) Edit text
- 2) Change background colors and fonts
- 3) Insert images and other files (.pdf, excel, and word)
- 4) Create frames
- 5) Connect ideas (paths)
- 6) Show presentation



Adding a YouTube video:

1) Copy YouTube video URL and paste it onto your Prezi wall.

Once you've created your Prezi presentation, you can:

- 1) Edit your presentation
- 2) Save a copy of your presentation
- 3) Download the presentation to a portable drive or your primary computer for offline access
- 4) Share your presentation with a friend, colleague or teacher
- 5) Embed your presentation on a website
- 6) Make your presentation viewable to the public
- 7) Invite others to collaborate with you
