

- ❑ Find information on your topic using books in the **Reference Collection** (encyclopedias, dictionaries, handbooks, etc.)
- ❑ Books in Reference are grouped together by **subject**.
- ❑ The **first letter(s)** of a book's **call number** is the clue to its subject:

GN = anthropology (culture, customs) **LB** = education

1. What country are you researching? _____
2. The country is located in what **continent**? _____
3. Find information about your country in each of the following books:

- *Worldmark Encyclopedia of Cultures and Daily Life* **Ref GN333 .W67**

v. 1 = Africa	←
v. 2 = Americas	
v. 3 = Asia and Oceania	
v. 4 = Europe	

- Arranged by **continent**. 4 volumes
- Look at the **Country Index** (in front of each book) for volume and page numbers.
- Good for information about “**rites of passage**” in each country.

- *World Education Encyclopedia* **Ref LB15 .W87 2001**

- Countries are listed alphabetically. **Vol.1 = A-H** **Vol.2 = I-R** **Vol.3 = S-Z**
- Copy the “**Basic Data**” and “**Preprimary & Primary Education**” sections.

4. Make copies of the information you found in the books.
 - Also, copy the **title page** of each book
 - Look on the **back** of the title page for the **date**.
5. Write each book’s **citation** information (author, title, publisher, place of publication, date, pages) on the **Works Cited** handout.

Find information about your country using the **online CultureGrams**.

1. At the **Cannell Library home page**, select **Reference Tools** (in left column), then select **CultureGrams**.
2. At the CultureGrams page, select **World Edition**. Open **Select a Region or Country** (upper left corner) and select your country.
 - Good for general information and “fun facts”.

Find information about your country using the **online Encyclopedia Britannica**.

1. At the **Cannell Library home page**, select **Reference Tools** (in left column), then select **Encyclopedia Britannica Online**.
2. Type your country’s name in the search box.
3. The results page will have 3 columns. In the 2nd column, select your country.
4. At your country’s page, select **Education**.
