Subject Guides and Search Engines

 **Subject Guides:** lists of links, usually a particular topic or theme. Examples:

Search the Web → Web Sites by Subject → Geography and Places

Search the Web → Web Sites by Subject → Women's Studies

 **Search Engines:** **Google.com** is a good general search engine. Search Tips:

- Place quotes around phrases: "family planning" russia
- You do not need to put "and" between your terms
- Case does not matter: Family Planning = family planning
- Word order matters; try variations.

! TIME SAVER ! To locate your keywords in a web page, from the menu bar, select **Edit** → **Find**, then enter one of your words in the search box.

Locating Books on Your Topic:

Hints for finding books in the Library Catalog:

1. Keyword Search: **culture and customs** retrieves records for two sets of books:
 - *Culture Shock! [country name]* = Business/Work issues
 - *Culture and Customs of [country name]* (In index, look under Marriage, Gender)
2. To limit to a country in Keyword Search: **culture and customs and Italy**
3. Or, in Keyword Search: **women and Italy**


Locating Films or Documentaries:

Hints for finding DVDs/videos in the Library Catalog:

- In **Keyword** search, type: **women and Afghanistan**. Open the “Material Type” dropdown box, select **DVDs/Videos**

For **more** DVDs/videos, search **Summit** (38 academic libraries in Washington, Oregon).

- Select **Advanced Search**, then, under **Format** select **Visual Material**.
