



Fire Safety

In the event of a fire, will you be prepared? If you are like most of us, you may not know what the most important steps are in saving your life. In both the home and workplace, there are certain fire safety practices that must be followed in order to protect yourself and others in a fire. The first step is to be aware of what you can do to prepare.

Clark College Fire Protocols:

- Activate the nearest fire alarm pull station.
- Evacuate the building promptly.
- Do not use elevator.
- Do not re-enter building until “All Clear” message is received.

Requirements:

- Ensure that fire extinguishers have clear access of at least 3 feet in every direction.
- Ensure that exit routes are clear and unobstructed; including storage, furniture or equipment.
- Ensure that fire and exit doors are unobstructed by items or door stops.
