

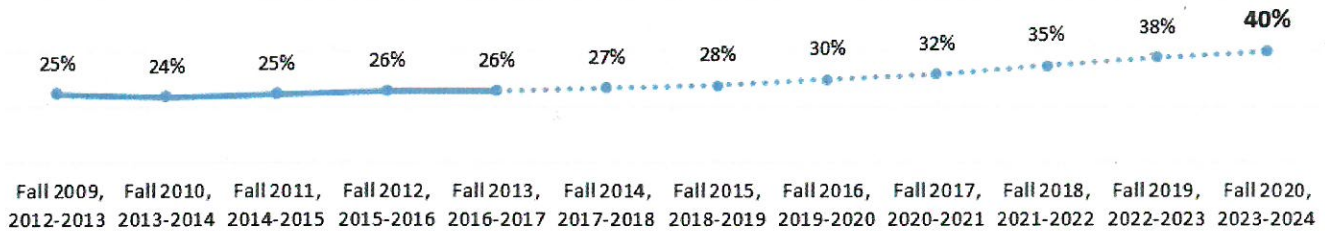

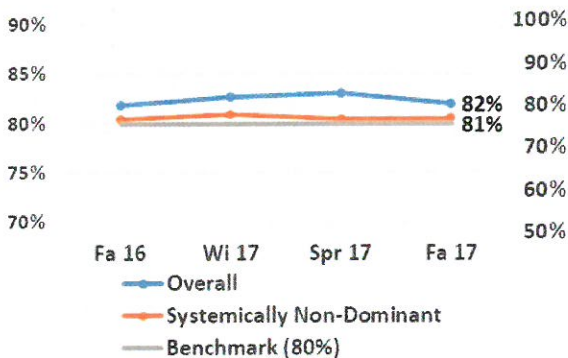

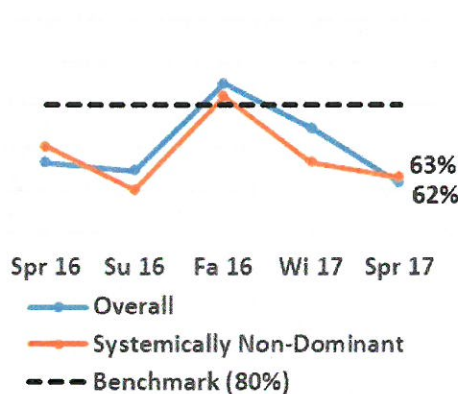
Degree or Certificate-Seeking Full-Time Student Completion Rate Within 3 Years



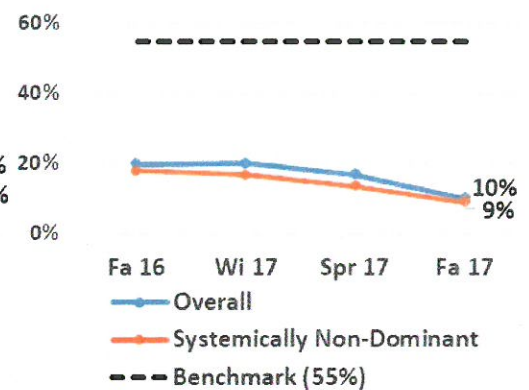
Course Success Rate: Certificate or Degree-Seeking Students
