

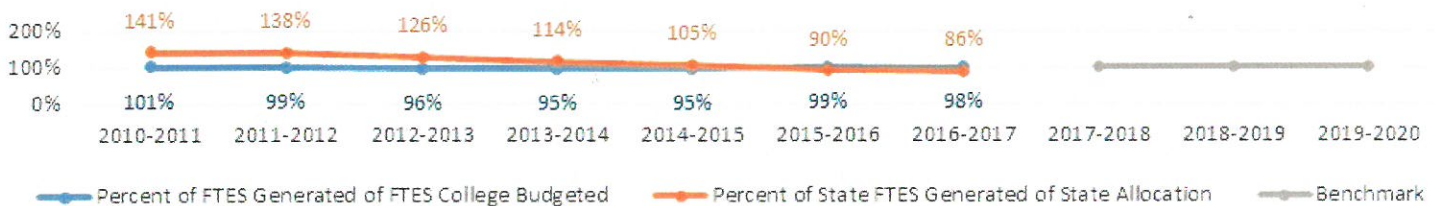

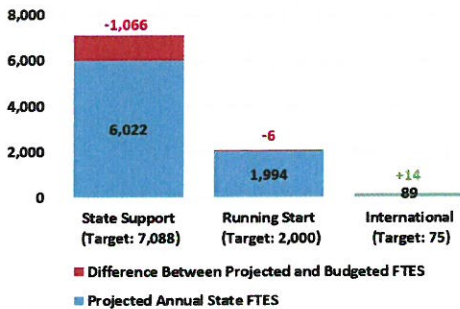

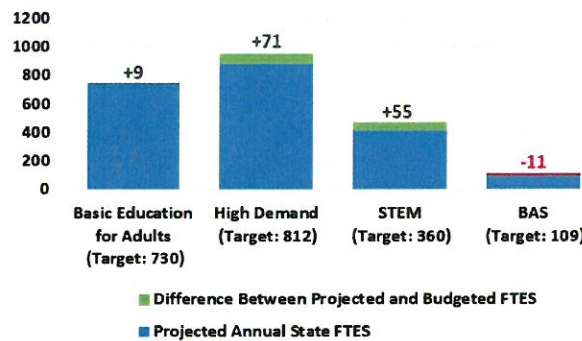
Percent of Full-Time Equivalent Students (FTES) Generated based on College Budget and State Allocation



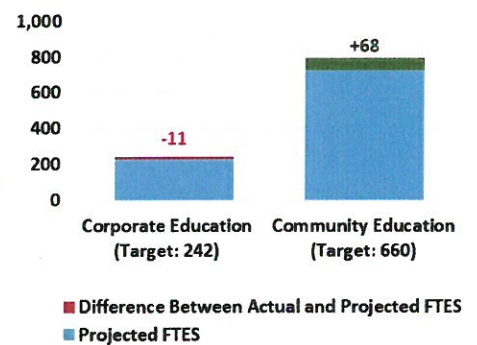
Projected Final Annual FTES Based on Current FTES (Feb 1)
