Clark Junior Offering Two-semester Plan With Two-hour Sessions Weekly

Evening courses sponsored by Clark junior college will begin tonight, at the Vancouver high school, and will continue, in a two-semester division, until next June, according to Homer P. Foster, acting dean. Instructors will include Pearl S. Hall, in arts; Ralph W. Hanna, in languages, Mr. Foster in history, and Margaret Page Johnson in literature.

Courses will last for two-hour sessions one evening per week, and will include arts and crafts, modern literature, world wars, and Spanish. In addition, courses in other subjects will be added where enough students wish it.
