## College May Close Doors Unless Registrations of Evening Students Increase

Enrollments may now be made for evening classes at the Clark Junior college, according to an announcement from the college, which is considering suspending activities for the duration of the war unless a considerable number of students enroll for the spring semester. The college work is now limited to the evening classes, which are offered three times a week.
