2010 Edition Submission Guidelines

Every student enrolled in a 100 level course or above at Clark is eligible to submit artwork for consideration. The requirements for submission involve writing a contributor statement, filling out a submission form, and submitting your work to the Art Office by the appropriate deadline. Publication date is set for early May 2010.

The Contributor's Statement

To be considered for publication in the Phoenix, every contributor MUST provide a brief statement (75 words or less) addressing one of the following questions for each piece the contributor submits:

What do you like best about this piece? or Why is this piece important to you?

Literary Art

To submit your original literary work by email, please attach your literary work, your contributor's statement and your name and contact information to an e-mail. The piece MUST be double-spaced in a Microsoft Word format and should include a title. Send email to phoenix@clark.edu. You should receive a confirmation of receipt within 10 business days.
