Student Checklist for Program Entry Requirements

The following items must be **completed and submitted** to the Allied Health Office in T-Building 122 **prior to the first day of 1st quarter class** (unless otherwise noted)

- Orientation session prior to start of program (**mandatory**)
 - A signed copy of **Confidentially Statement** form
 - A signed copy of **Acknowledgement of Hazards and Risks** form
 - A signed copy of **Release of Information** form
 - A signed copy of **Clinical Placement Agreement** form
 - A completed **Student Information** form
 - **Criminal Background checks** must be completed prior to the first day of your program using CertifiedProfile.com and the access code for your program. The student access information is available on the Canvas online Orientation site in the Criminal Background Check module. The results are secured online and accessed by program personnel so no need to provide a print out for your student file, (please allow up to 7 business days of processing time for completion).
- ❖ The following items must be **completed and uploaded to CertifiedProfile.com**:

Student Health and Immunization Requirements (as per clinical site requirements, additional details given at orientation)

- **Complete Medical Clearance**— Physical within three (3) months of start of program utilizing the Health Services Medical Clearance for Program Participation Form
- **MMR** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) – Two (2) doses of MMR or proof of immunity (positive titer)
- **Hepatitis B** – Series of three (3) doses, and proof of immunity (positive titer)
- **Varicella** (Chicken Pox) - Two (2) doses of the Varicella vaccine or proof of immunity (positive titer)
- **Tetanus/Diphtheria** (Tdap) – 1-time dose of Tdap. Booster of Td every 10 yrs.
- **Tuberculosis Skin Testing** (PPD/TST) - Complete within three (3) months of the start of the program, if no prior yearly TB skin test, a negative two-step PPD/TST(1-3 weeks between Step 1 and Step 2). If having a previous negative PPD, once a year on or before the date of last negative test. In the case of a positive PPD/TST provide documentation of a clear chest x-ray or negative QFT-G.
- **FLU Vaccine** - Annual vaccine in the fall once the vaccine is available and the flu season is announced.

Upload your Documentation via CertifiedProfile.com for the following (additional details given at orientation and via CANVAS):

- Current Healthcare Provider **CPR** (American Heart Association guidelines) certification must be kept current during the entire clinical experience, HLTH 124 (formerly FACPR 032) meets this requirement
- **First Aid** certification, HLTH 124 (formerly FACPR 032) meets this requirement
- Copy of **AIDS Education** certificate (HEOC 120, or a minimum 4 hours AIDS Education certificate)
- Copy of current **Health Insurance** card (medical and accident, as per clinical site requirements)
- Copy of Washington Pharmacy Assistant License
- Copy of Oregon Pharmacy Technician License

Proof of satisfactory completion of courses below (prior to 2nd quarter) with a grade of “C” or better:

- BMED 111—Medical Terminology II
- CMST&210, Interpersonal Communications **OR** CMST&230, Small Group Communications

Obtain a Clark College **Pharmacy Tech Student Program Identification Badge** from Clark Security Office in Gaiser Hall (obtain prior to first day of 2nd quarter classes).
