Northwest Regional Training Center

EMT 103 is taught by the Northwest Regional Training Center (see back for map). The Training Center requires students to bring the following to the first night of class:

- Copy of current Healthcare Provider CPR card (or take IFA 032)
- Copy of valid Drivers License
- WA State criminal background check (within 6 mos. of course date)
- MMR immunization (twice in lifetime or within last 10 yrs.)
- Hepatitis B immunization (series of 3) or signed waiver
- Negative Tuberculosis skin test or chest x-ray (within past 6 mos.)
- Must be 18 years of age
- Proof of high school completion (transcripts) or GED

FROM SOUTH BOUND I-205

Start out going South on I-205

Take the N.E. 83rd ST/PADDEN PKWY exit exit number 32

Turn LEFT onto NE 83RD ST. / PADDEN PKWY E. Continue to follow PADDEN PKWY E.

Turn RIGHT onto NE 117TH AVE/WA-503.

Turn RIGHT onto NE 66TH ST.

Turn RIGHT into parking lot

FROM NORTH BOUND I-205

Start out going North on I-205

Take exit number 30 and follow the signs for SR 500 East

Follow signs for SR 503 North or Battle Ground (SR 503 is also known as 117th AV)

Turn LEFT at the light onto NE 65th ST

Turn RIGHT onto NE 116th AV

Turn RIGHT onto NE 66th ST

Turn LEFT into parking lot
