Degree Completion Requirements

Clark College offers a Degree Completion program for practicing Paramedics. Students who currently hold EMT-Paramedic Certification for the National Registry (no exceptions) and who wish to complete an Associate in Applied Science—Paramedicine at Clark College must:

✓	TASKS
<input type="checkbox"/>	1. Complete the Clark College Application for Admission and the Clark College Health Occupation Application . Return them to the Clark College Admissions Office with the \$40.00 non-refundable application fee.
<input type="checkbox"/>	2. Submit proof of current Paramedic certification from the National Registry. (Must be two years current upon degree completion.)
<input type="checkbox"/>	3. Submit official transcript from the school/training facility from which you completed your Paramedic courses.
<input type="checkbox"/>	4. Complete all courses listed under Required Course Checklist (see p. 8) with a 2.0 or above.
<input type="checkbox"/>	5. All degree seeking students must have completed 30 quarter credit hours at Clark College (including no more than 3 PE credits) to meet college residency requirements. (These 30 credits do not need to be the most recent credits earned.) Courses labeled EMT-P will not count toward this requirement.
<input type="checkbox"/>	6. Upon successful completion of the above requirements, a \$45 transcription fee will be required.

TRANSFERRING COLLEGE CREDIT

Official transcripts must be submitted before an evaluation can be completed. Course numbers and titles vary from college to college. Equivalency of transfer credits is determined by **course content**. Course credit hours and equivalency will be determined by Clark College. It **MAY** be necessary for candidates to *submit course descriptions and/or syllabi* to determine equivalency. Submitting a complete syllabus will allow for the most accurate evaluation. Courses accepted as equivalent at one college **may not be** equivalent at another college.

General courses (non-science):

For each course you wish to transfer, submit the course description(s) and a copy of the catalog cover that verifies the college and the year you took the course(s).

Science:

Requires a copy of the syllabus from each course you wish evaluated. The syllabus must show the appropriate year and quarter you took the course. If a syllabus showing the appropriate year and quarter is not available, a letter from the college's Science Department needs to accompany the syllabus. This cover letter must verify that the content and coverage of the course taken is the same as the course content listed on the syllabus. It must also state the name of the text used during the quarter you took the course(s).
