AT WSU VANCOUVER

Please arrive a few minutes early so you can successfully find your way to your first class.

LIBRARY SERVICES: All Clark students need a Clark Student Body I.D. Card to check out or order library materials from the WSU Vancouver Library or "SUMMIT". (For information about the "SUMMIT" Library Alliance, which Clark is a member of, please contact the Library Reference Desk at either WSU Vancouver or Clark College).

COMPUTER LABS: Clark students at WSU Vancouver will use the computer labs in the Clark Center. The lab is located in CCW 202.

CCW 102 is the CAD (Engineering) lab and the Computer Science lab. CCW 104 is used for some English classes.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION ACCESS TO WSU VANCOUVER:

Clark students may purchase a C-TRAN pass from the Security/Information Desk at Clark College. A C-TRAN pass is \$19 per quarter. Please look for the most current C-TRAN schedule at Clark Security, Gaiser Hall, or next to the bookstore. Students may call C-TRAN for route information at 360-695-0123 or visit www.c-tran.com.

FOOD SERVICE: Vending machines are available on the ground floor of the Clark Center. WSU Vancouver also has a café that offers entrees, salads and sandwiches and a full coffee bar. The café is located on the first floor of the WSU Vancouver Student Services Building and open when WSU Vancouver classes are in session from 7:30 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Thursday and from 7:30 am to 1:30 pm on Fridays. Hours are limited during WSU Vancouver's summer session from May through July. The WSU Vancouver Bookstore also carries light snacks, coffee and beverages.

PARKING: WSU Vancouver uses a system of required parking permits or direct parking space payment. Permits or direct payment are required of all persons parking on the campus between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday. All parking permits may be purchased from the WSU Vancouver Public Safety Office located one building east of the Engineering & Life Sciences Building at WSU Vancouver. Clark quarterly permits are available. For information about parking fees and a map of WSU Vancouver, please visit <http://www.vancouver.wsu.edu/adm/fo/psafety/parking.htm>.

NOTE: A 3-Quarter Permit should be valid until June (please check the expiration date on all permits, whether you buy one each quarter or for all 3 quarters). If you wish to pay daily, you will need to park in the Blue Lot (the cash pay lot) and place your receipt on the dash of your vehicle. The cash pay ticket dispenser does not give change.

BOOKSTORE: Textbooks for Clark College classes offered at WSU Vancouver must be purchased at the Clark College Bookstore or on-line. The WSU Vancouver Bookstore, “The Bookie”, has supplies, snacks and merchandise available for purchase. The Bookie’s hours are 10 am to 6 pm, Monday through Thursday and 9 am to 5 pm on Friday. Their summer hours are 9 am to 4 pm, Monday through Friday. The Bookie phone number is 573-0447.
