



Library & eLearning Services for Clark Nursing Students – 2009-2010 WSU Vancouver Library and Cannell Library at Clark College

Library Cards:

- Nursing students may use their Clark ID card to check-out or to request library materials from the Clark College Library. If you already have a Clark library card you may use that also.
- WSU Vancouver will ask for a Clark ID or driver's license and ask that you to fill out a form. You will be assigned a WSU student number in order to check out reserve and other materials at WSU Vancouver.

Course Reserves:

- If nursing faculty put videos or DVDs on Reserve in the WSU Vancouver Library for student use, they will be available at the Reserves Desk.

SUMMIT:

- To locate books not owned at Clark or WSU Vancouver, use the SUMMIT library catalog. This is the shared catalog of 39 academic libraries in Washington and Oregon. Students may choose to have books delivered to the library of their choice (within the SUMMIT system). You will have to pre-arrange this. See below.
- You must register in advance at the pick-up library, if it is not Clark College. In the case of WSU Vancouver, use your WSU number (see library cards above) to have books sent to WSUV.
- Allow 5 days for book delivery. You'll be pleasantly surprised if they come sooner.
- Links to Summit are found on the websites for both libraries. For more information contact Clark College Circulation at (360) 992-2504.

InterLibrary Loan Services:

- For journal articles or books not available at the WSU Vancouver Library, from the Clark College collection/databases, or from Summit, Clark students should use the Cannell Library's online ordering form on the Cannell Library web page (<http://www.clark.edu/Library/Resources/ill.html>). Journal articles will be delivered on-line whenever possible.
- Students should make every effort to order books through the Summit System. Books that are ordered through ILL will be delivered to Cannell Library and must be picked up there.

Library Database Access:

- Clark students may access Clark databases on and off-campus through the Cannell Library Web site (<http://www.clark.edu/Library>). Students should use their Clark College ID number for access. Nursing students are advised to use *CINAHL* or *Health Source Nursing Academic* databases for research and to call the Reference Desk at Cannell Library (992-2375) for assistance.
- Clark students will have full access to the WSU Vancouver Library's databases in the WSU Vancouver Library building, but will not be able to access these databases from off campus or in the Clark Center building.

eLearning/ Blackboard:

- Clark students who need assistance with their online courses may contact the eLearning office in person or by phone (360-992-2654 or 877-748-2654).
