## What Is It?

The Co-Admission & Enrollment Program is an opportunity for students to complete one application process for enrollment at Clark College and Concordia University (CU). The program is open to all transfer programs.

## What Are The Benefits?

## Admission Criteria For Transfer Students

Transfer students with more than 12 semester hours or 18 quarter hours may be eligible for admission provided they have a 2.0 cumulative GPA. Transfer credits that are ten years and older may fulfill course requirements, but will not apply to cumulative GPA.

## The Following Must be Received to Process Your Application:

- Undergraduate application for admission
- Official transcripts of all completed coursework at institutions previously attended other than Clark and CU
- Two letters of recommendation
- Students new to Clark College, please be aware there is a one-time, non-refundable \$20 admission application fee.

## Resident Living

Students must be enrolled full-time at Concordia University each semester in order to live on campus. Housing assignments are given priority based upon receipt date of completed housing application with \$150 tuition and housing deposit made payable to Concordia University. ## Deadline

Concordia University has a rolling admission process. However, applications submitted by the application deadlines listed are given priority. Nursing students have different deadlines; please contact your Concordia transfer coordinator for details.

## Application Decision

Students will receive an admission decision within two weeks of completion of all application material. When admission is offered, the student will be asked to submit:

1. Tuition deposit of \$100. The deposit is applied directly toward tuition. If the above deadlines have passed, the deposit is due thirty days after acceptance and is non-refundable after thirty days of receipt.
2. Housing deposit of \$50 and application form if you seek on-campus housing. Housing deposit and tuition deposit may be paid together.
3. Health History Form.
4. Certificate of Immunization Form (required by Oregon State Law).
