

## 2011-2012 Cost of Attendance

Federal Regulations require schools to establish average costs for attending each college. The cost of attending Clark College includes tuition and fees, books and supplies, room and board, personal and transportation costs. Students that incur additional program and childcare costs may ask for a budget adjustment to cover the costs. Budgets are based on a survey conducted every three years by the Washington Financial Aid Association and completed by students throughout the state. In non survey years the budgets are established based on actual tuition and fee increases and the Consumer Price Index.
