- How to seek out true authentic Hawaiian cultural activities.

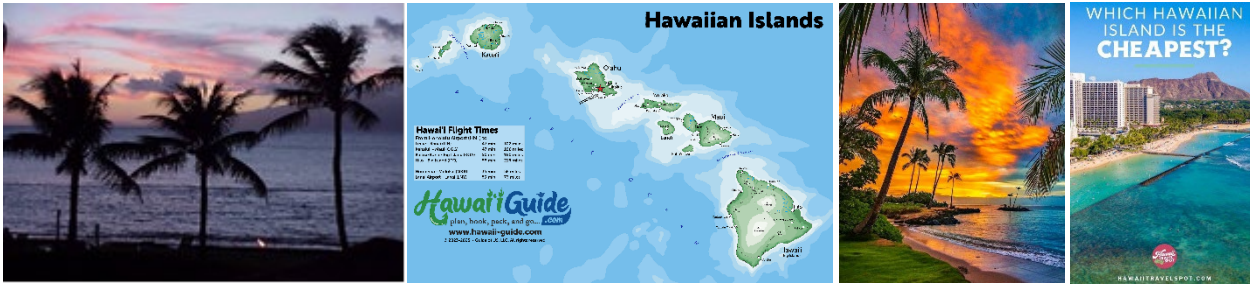
Course Schedule
