

## What Is It?

The Co-Admission & Enrollment Program is an opportunity for students to complete one application process for enrollment at Clark College and Marylhurst University (MU). The program is open to all transfer programs.

## What Are The Benefits?

- One application process for both Clark and Marylhurst
- Clark/Marylhurst advising available at either campus
- Increased flexibility in scheduling with access to more classes
- Financial aid available for qualified students admitted under the dual admission/enrollment program
- Access to library and computer lab resources on both campuses
- Career Services support, including internship programs
- Skill-building through preparatory courses at Clark and lower division courses at either Clark or Marylhurst
- Opportunity to access services and participate in college life on both campuses
- Free parking at Marylhurst
- Easier transition from community college to university

## **General Application Requirements**

All students applying to undergraduate degree and certificate programs at Marylhurst University must submit:

- A completed and signed Co-Admission Application form.
- Additional documentation as indicated by the applicant's classification below.
- Full-time, on-campus students born on or after January 1, 1957 must submit verification of measles immunization.
- Sealed, official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended.
- A Letter of Intent outlining academic goals.
- Verification of high school completion or equivalency (waived for students who have 90 transferable credits or who have earned an AA/AS degree).

Some departments require additional materials to accept a student to a specialized area of study. To determine department specific requirements, contact the Office of Admissions.

## **Minimum GPA Requirements**

Applicants with fewer than 20 transferable college credits are asked to submit official high school transcripts which must show a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.00 scale, or a GED score of 50. Applicants with previous college credit must submit official transcripts with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.00 scale.

## **Application Deadlines and Policies**

Applications are accepted year round, with four enrollment start times annually. Applications not completed by the last add/drop date of the term for which you are applying will be withdrawn. If you have trouble with any application requirements, please contact the Office of Admissions.

## **Application Decision**

Students will receive an admission decision within two weeks of completion of all application material.
