

State High School Diploma Eligibility

Background: State Bill SHB 1758 was approved by the Legislature and took effect July 26, 2009, in order to expand options for students to earn high school diplomas.

Summary: Students who meet the criteria below can request in writing that the college issue a state high school diploma to them if they:

- Have not previously earned a high school diploma or GED <u>AND</u>
- Have completed an associate degree of any kind at Clark College <u>AND ARE EITHER</u>
 - o An individual 21 years or older

<u>OR</u>

• An individual either currently or previously enrolled through Running Start; please indicate high school previously attended if under age 21_____
