



## State High School Diploma Eligibility

**Background:** State Bill SHB 1758 was approved by the Legislature and took effect July 26, 2009, in order to expand options for students to earn high school diplomas.

**Summary:** Students who meet the criteria below can request in writing that the college issue a state high school diploma to them if they:

- Have not previously earned a high school diploma or GED  
**AND**
  - Have completed an associate degree of any kind at Clark College  
**AND ARE EITHER**
    - An individual 21 years or older
- OR**
- An individual either currently or previously enrolled through Running Start; please indicate high school previously attended if under age 21 \_\_\_\_\_
