**WHY:** **Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI)–**

The MBTI helps you identify your personality preferences in a four-letter “personality type” and summarizes the results in a career report. Based on your type, the report provides research-based information about popular career choices and strategies for career exploration. **Strong Interest Inventory (SII) –**

The SII helps you understand your personal interests and the relationship to desirable work environments/occupations. The research-based SII report provides quantitative results describing your personality, areas of greatest interest, and how you relate to people from a variety of occupations. **HOW:** The Myers-Briggs Type Indicator and Strong Interest Inventory Assessments must be completed online at least 24 hours prior to your interpretation appointment.

**COST:** Each assessment costs \$20 for current students and \$30 for non-students, which includes scoring of assessment and a 1½ -hour small group interpretation taught by a Career Advisor.
