#### **Guidelines:**

- Limit <u>one</u> photo submission per person.
- No selfies.
- Digital submissions only.
- Must be no larger than 2MB; JPEG only; Medium to high resolution.
- Photo must be taken within the last 5 years.
- Photoshop or other photo editing software may not be used.
- No captions or borders allowed.
