

Clark musicians present 2006-07 orchestra season

The Clark College Orchestra, under the direction of Donald Lawrence Appert, will present the 2006-07 "Season of Delights." orchestra for the season finale.

All concerts will be held in the Royal Durst Theatre of the Vancouver School of Arts and Academics.

"Turkish Delight" will be presented Wednesday, Nov. 29, 2006, in which Italian pianist Maurizio Barboro is the featured soloist in Beethoven's "Piano Concerto No. 1," and concertmaster Gretchen Tucker will be featured in Rimsky-Korsakov's "Scherzade." The concert will be under the direction of guest conductor Emin Guven Yaslicam, the music director of the Adana Symphony in Turkey.

On March 7, 2007, the group presents "Czech Delight," with Emil-Silviu Ciobota, a violinist from Cologne, Germany, serving as the soloists for Mozart's "Violin Concerto No. 6." The well-known "Symphony No. 8" of Antonin Dvorak is the "Czech Delight" of the show. The guest conductor is Slawomir Chrzanowski, the music director of the Zabrze Philharmonic of Poland.

The season concludes with "Viennese Delight," on Sunday, June 3, 2007. The concert features Mahler's "Symphony No. 4", with April Brookins Duvic, adjunct instructor of voice at Clark College joining at the soprano soloist for the final movement. Appert will lead the
