

Nutter Corp. develops leaders through Clark College

Clark College's Corporate Education department provided supervisory skills training to 30 of Vancouver's Nutter Corp.'s field construction workers earlier this month.

Nutter is the leading producer of the Portland Metro and Southwest Washington region's road construction, underground utilities and excavation projects for municipal, commercial and residential developments. Nutter employs more than 165 workers constructing roads, underground utilities and other excavation projects.
