Lower Columbia men defeat Clark

Four Penguins reach double figures in loss

Germain Jordan scored 27 points and grabbed 10 rebounds Tuesday to lead unbeaten Lower Columbia to a 76-68 men's basketball win over Clark College at the O'Connell Center.

The game opened conference play for both teams.

Erving Adams had 15 points and 14 rebounds for the Clark, which had four players score in double figures. Adams also had five steals.

Drew Bleth scored 13 points for the Penguins, Drew Bergeron 11 and Josias Flynn 10.

Clark limited the Red Devils to 41 percent shooting and kept

the contest close.

Lower Columbia women 73, at Clark 46 — Three players scored in double figures for the visiting Red Devils and the Penguins shot only 23 percent in the conference opener for both teams at the O'Connell Center.

Stephanie Woullard had 12 points and seven rebounds, and Maryam Razavi scored 11 points for Clark.
