

Clark club baseball squad falls to Linfield JV in doubleheader

The Clark College club baseball team had a victory slip away on Saturday, falling in the first game of a doubleheader to the Linfield JV 6-5 at the Clark College field.

Linfield completed the sweep with a 9-0 win in the second game.

"Overall, we played well," said Clark coach Lee Brand of the first game. "We just couldn't finish."

Clark (5-12) took a 5-4 lead with a run in the sixth inning.

Prairie High grad Jackson Stellfox led off the sixth with a walk and advanced on a hit batter. He then stole third base and scored as the throw to third sailed into the outfield.

Linfield scored the game winning runs in the top of the seventh on a bases-loaded two-out throwing error.

Stellfox was 1 for 3 with two RBI. Fort Vancouver grad Zach Girod had an RBI triple in the third inning.

Clark managed just three hits in the second game.

Clark is scheduled to host Concordia in a doubleheader at noon today.
