

Clark tournament tips off today

The Clark College men's basketball Holiday Invitational begins its three-day run with four games today at the O'Connell Center.

Host Clark (4-2) takes on Umpqua CC (2-6) of Winchester, Ore., at 8 p.m. to cap off the opening-day schedule.

The Vancouver Island Mariners (8-3) of Nanaimo, B.C., open the tournament against Seattle CC (1-5) at 2 p.m.

Chemeketa (4-4) of Salem, Ore., vs. Big Bend (6-2) of Moses Lake play at 4 p.m., followed by Portland CC (3-4) vs. Wenatchee Valley (6-2) at 6 p.m.

Tuesday's consolation round games are scheduled for noon and 2 p.m. with the championship semifinals at 6 p.m. and 8 p.m. There will be a dunk and 3-point contest at 4 p.m.

The final round on Wednesday begins with the fourth-place game at noon, followed by the third-place game at 2 p.m. and the championship at 4 p.m.
