

Clark teams claim division, regional titles

The Clark College men's soccer team wrapped up the NWAACC South Division title with a 4-0 win over Pierce on Saturday in Vancouver.

Joel Duenas's goal gave the Penguins (13-1-1) the 1-0 lead at the half.

Prairie High grad **Brian Virgin** assisted on the Duenas goal and then put Clark up 2-0 with an unassisted goal. **Davor Lukic** and **Alex Atanason** also scored in the second half with assists from **Mike Brown**, an Evergreen grad, and **Martin Gonzalez**.

Mountain View grad **Whit Parker** recorded the shutout.

Clark, which beat South Puget Sound 2-1 on Friday, closes out the regular season on Nov. 4 at home against Southwestern Oregon before hosting a playoff game on Nov. 9.

■ At Lewisville Park in Battle Ground, the Clark women's cross country team held off three other squads to win the Southern Regional team title.

Evergreen grad **Danielle Hutchinson** was third overall on the 6K course with a time of 19 minutes, 35 seconds as the Penguins edged Mount Hood 34-41 with Lane third (55). Mount Hood's **Sheryl Page** was the overall winner in 18:46.

Heritage grad **Lindsey Kemp** was sixth (19:59) for Clark, followed by **Audra McNally** in seventh (20:05), Skyview grad **Stephanie Cooley** in eighth (20:25) and **Maria Gomulkiewicz** in 10th (20:44). **Kimberly Addy** was 19th (22:07).

In the men's race, Clark was third behind Lane and Clackamas. Lane runners took seven of the top eight places.

Mountain View grad **John Graves** led the Penguins, placing ninth in 26:58 on the 8K course. **Jesse McChesney** was 13th (27:36), **Riley Eoff** 16th (27:50), **John Hayes** 23rd (28:44) and **Josh Bernier** 27th (29:21).

Next for Clark is the NWAACC championships in Spokane on Nov. 11.
