**Washougal:** Fifteen Clark County residents and Clark College volunteers on Nov. 13 helped with restoration

efforts on a Columbia Land Trust property in Washougal. The volunteers planted around 100 trees

and removed invasive plants such as English ivy and Himalayan blackberry.

Columbia Land Trust recently acquired the

property, which was formerly used as a dump site. It hopes the trees can eventually provide habitat for birds that live along the Washougal River.
