Clark College wins health care grant

Clark College has received a grant from Meyer Memorial Trust to help pave the way for the electronic delivery of core health care classes at Clark. The \$106.500 grant will be used to purchase videoconferencing and production equipment to provide new learning options for students interested in health care careers. The Meyer Trust grant will fund one-third of the anticipated total cost for the project. The program will be launched once all of the funding is in place, possibly during the 2009-2010 academic

year.
