WHO: You, if you are looking for direction in choosing a major, choosing your first career, advancing in your organization or changing careers later in life.

WHAT: The Myers-Briggs Type Indicator and Strong Interest Inventory career assessments.

WHY: **Myers-Briggs Type Indicator –**

(MBTI) identifies and describes your strengths and unique preferences and helps you to answer the questions: "What would I enjoy doing?" and "How can I use my strengths to reach my career goal?"

Strong Interest Inventory –

(SII) identifies what you most enjoy doing by comparing your responses to those answers given by people who really love their jobs (in 122 different fields).

HOW: Coupons may be purchased at the Clark College bookstore, and exchanged for directions at the Career Center. The Myers-Briggs Type Indicator and Strong Interest Inventory Assessments must be completed online at least 24 hours prior to your interpretation appointment.

HOW MUCH: Each assessment costs \$20 which includes scoring, a Career Report describing your results, and a 1½ -hour small group interpretation taught by a certified Counselor/Instructor.
