
J. C. GRADUATES FIRST STUDENT

Exercises honoring the graduation of a lone student from the new Clark junior college were held today as the school closed its first year of operation. Under an unusual combination of circumstances, one student of the newly fledged Vancouver college, Mrs. Frances Bunnell Wilde, is eligible for graduation at the close of the present term. She came to the local institution after having already completed one year of college work at Oregon State college, and Pacific college at Newburg, Oregon.

Mrs. Wilde is well known in Vancouver social circles. She graduated from Vancouver high school in 1921 after completing four years work with a high average grade of 90. Her one term at Oregon State college was completed with an average grade of B and her Pacific college grade average was 95. At the Clark junior college, Mrs. Wilde maintained her high grade average with straight A work during her first two terms. Third term grade reports are not yet completed.
