

## Toner and Inkjet Cartridge Recycling

America alone uses over 350 million cartridges per year of which only 20% are recycled. Each cartridge can be re-used an average of 4-7 times. Remanufacturing plastic uses 80% less energy than making it from scratch. Re-using cartridges helps conserve natural resources and keeps them out of landfills where they can take centuries to decompose.

- Staples offer \$2 credit per cartridge
- Office Depot offers up to 200 reward points
- Some plans require a minimum monthly purchase or have an expiration date on credits
