Reusable Equipment

Recycling Equipment

Electronics that are not able to be used anymore can be recycled at a number of vendors in the area. These include Empower Up, IMS Electronics and any transfer site.

There are also a number of organizations that will repurpose your electronics for use by individuals that need emergency communication means or are trying to get their life back on track. This includes the YWCA cell phone program.
