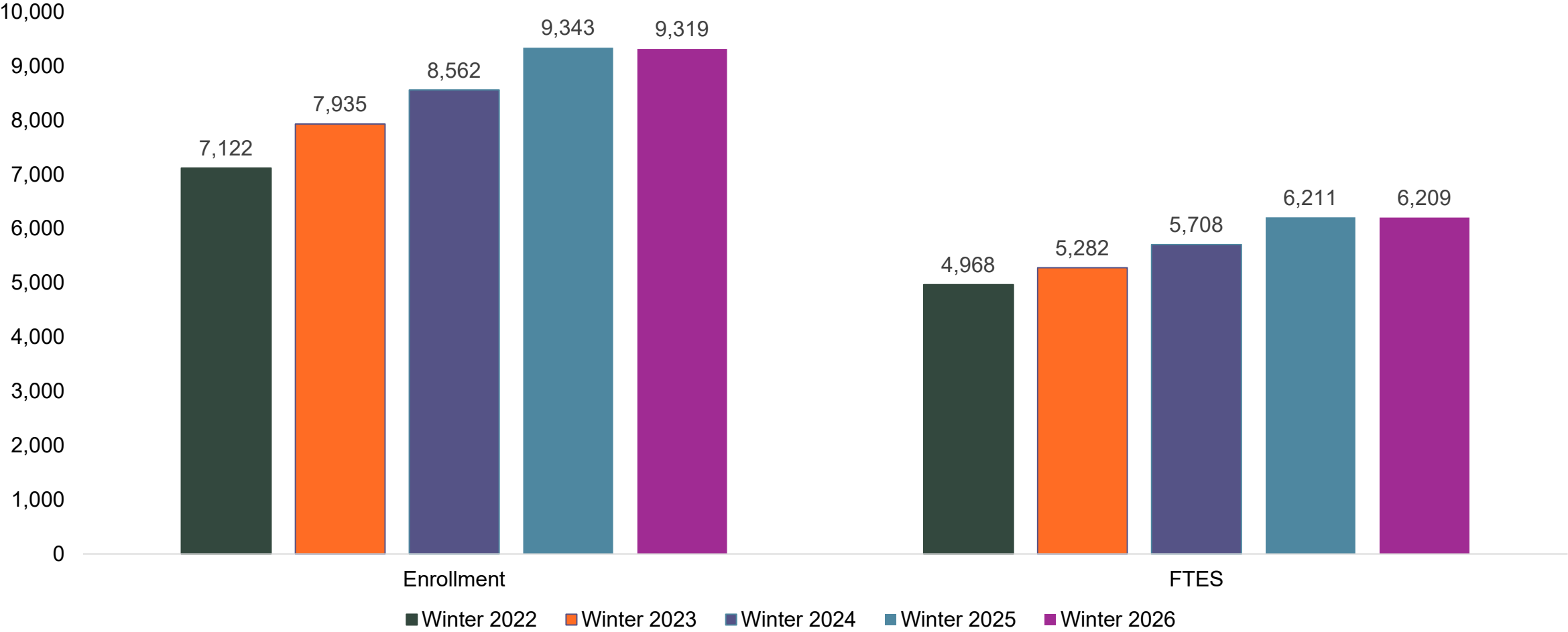

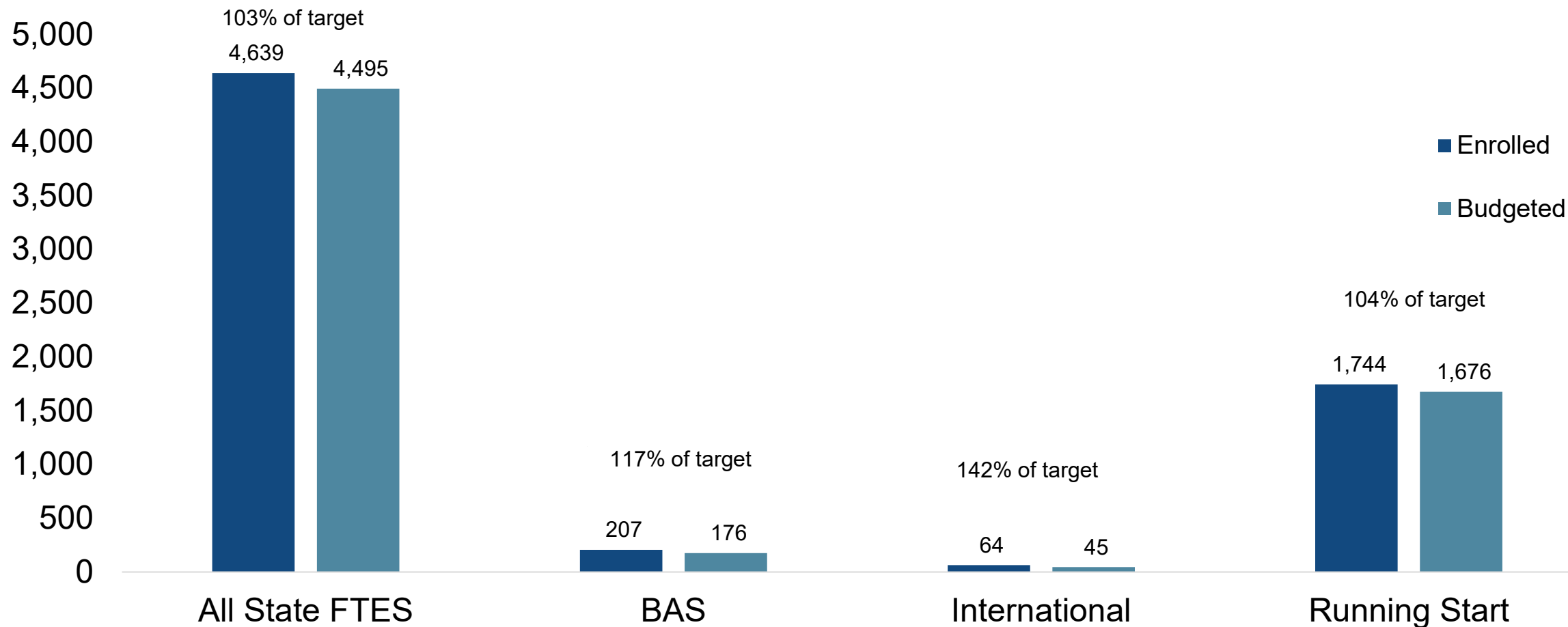

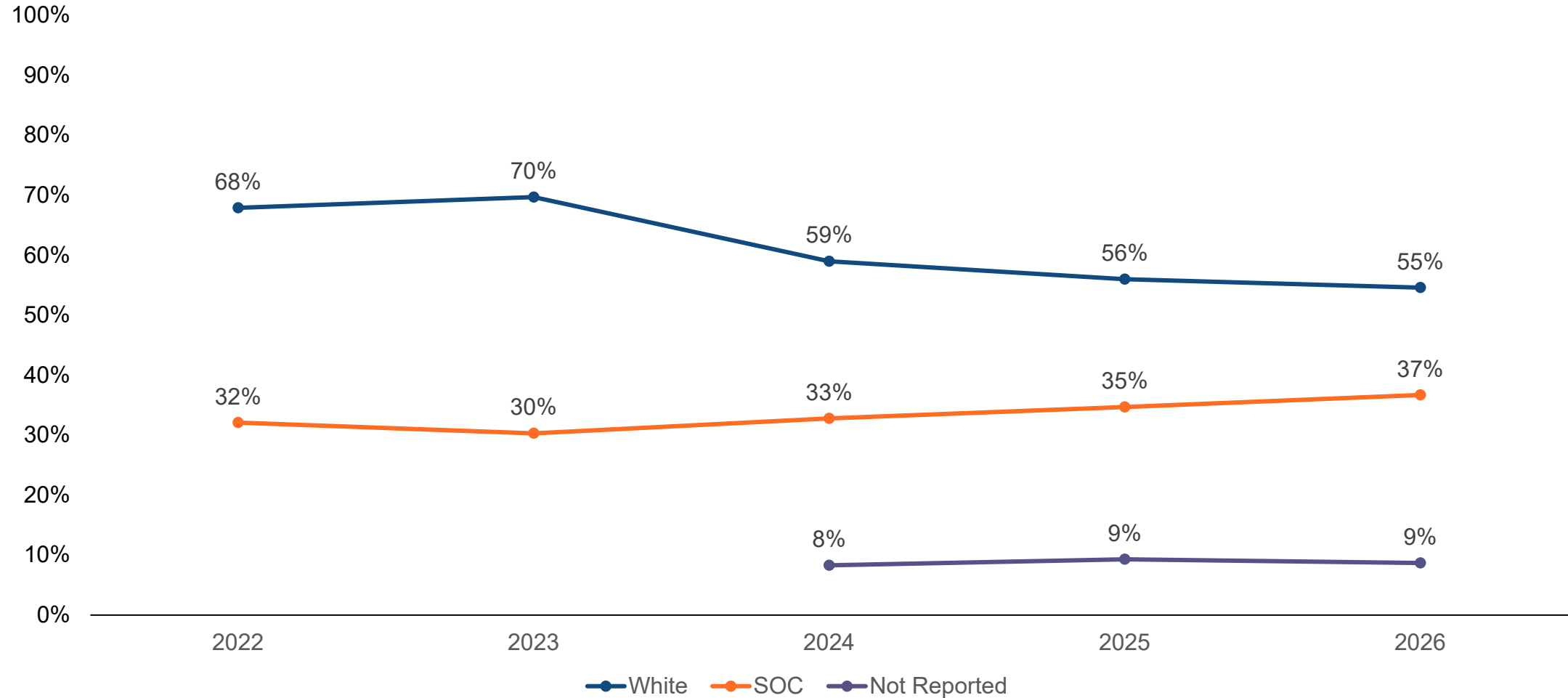

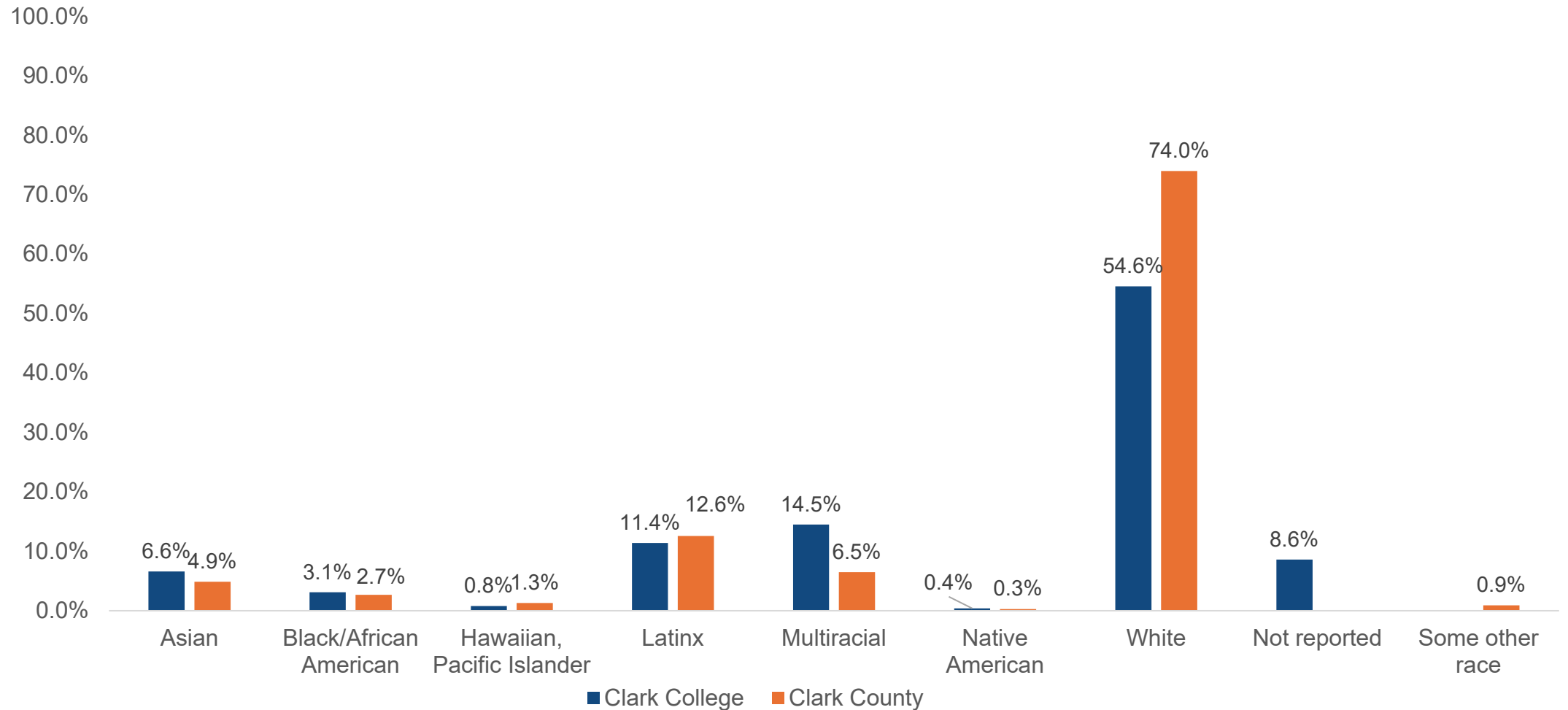

# Enrollment Trends of Students of Color as Compared to White Students, Winter 2022-2026

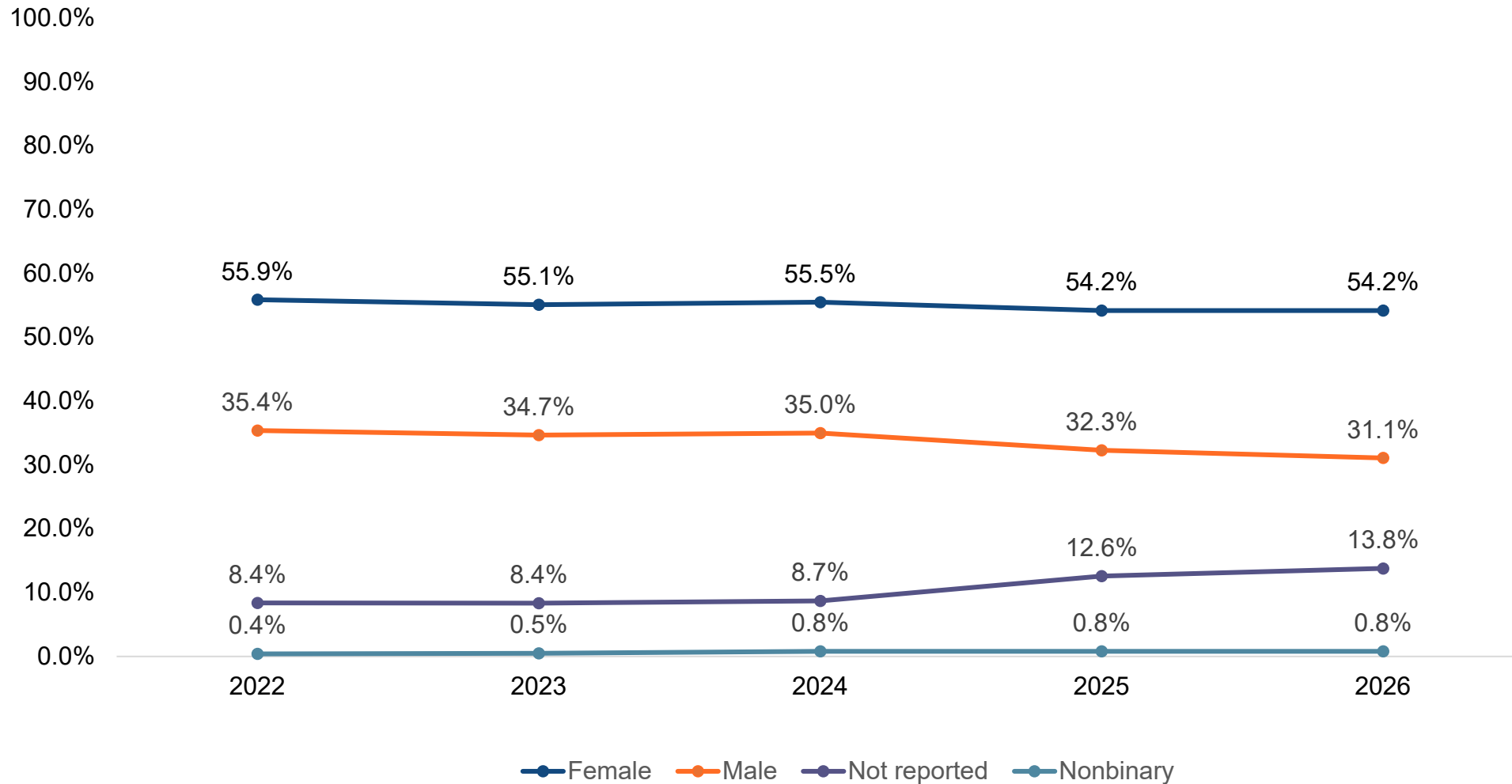

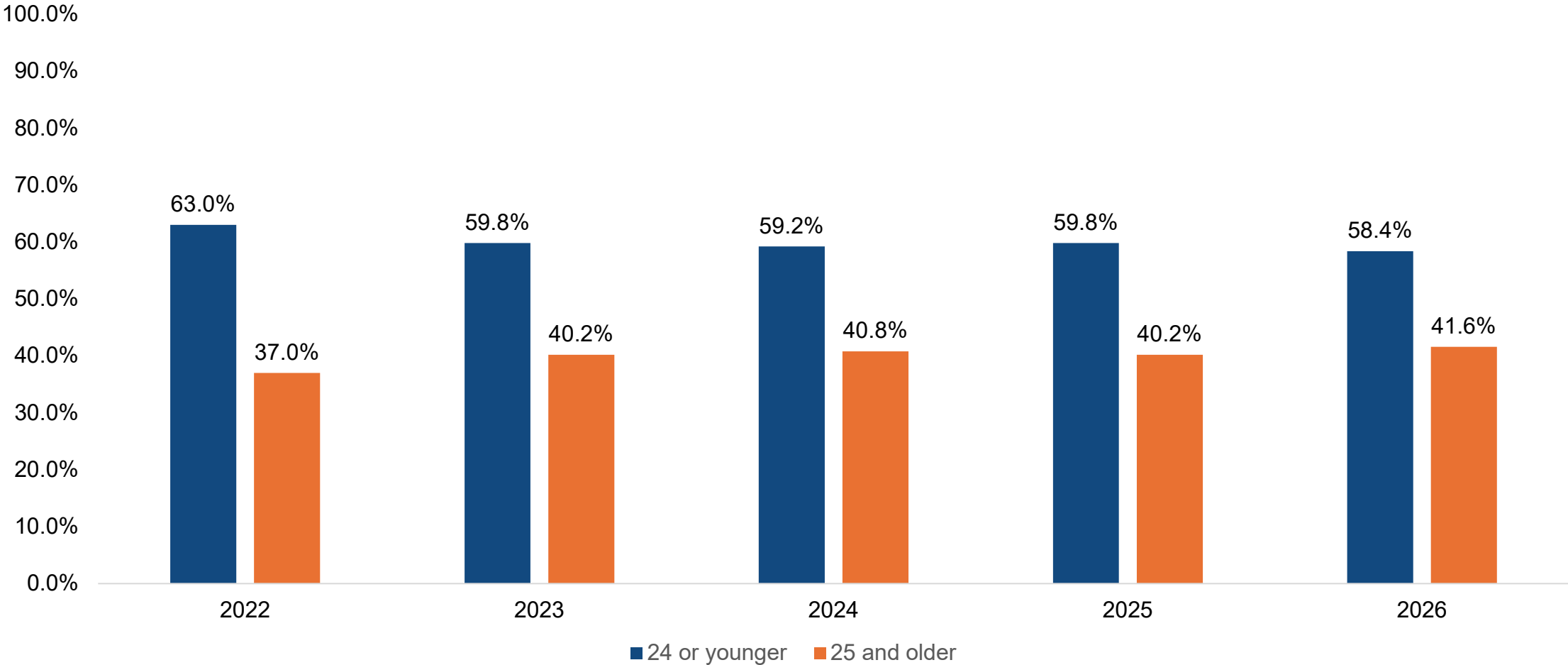
# Race/Ethnicity of Clark Students Compared to Clark County, Winter 2026



# Sex of Clark Students, Winter 2022-2026



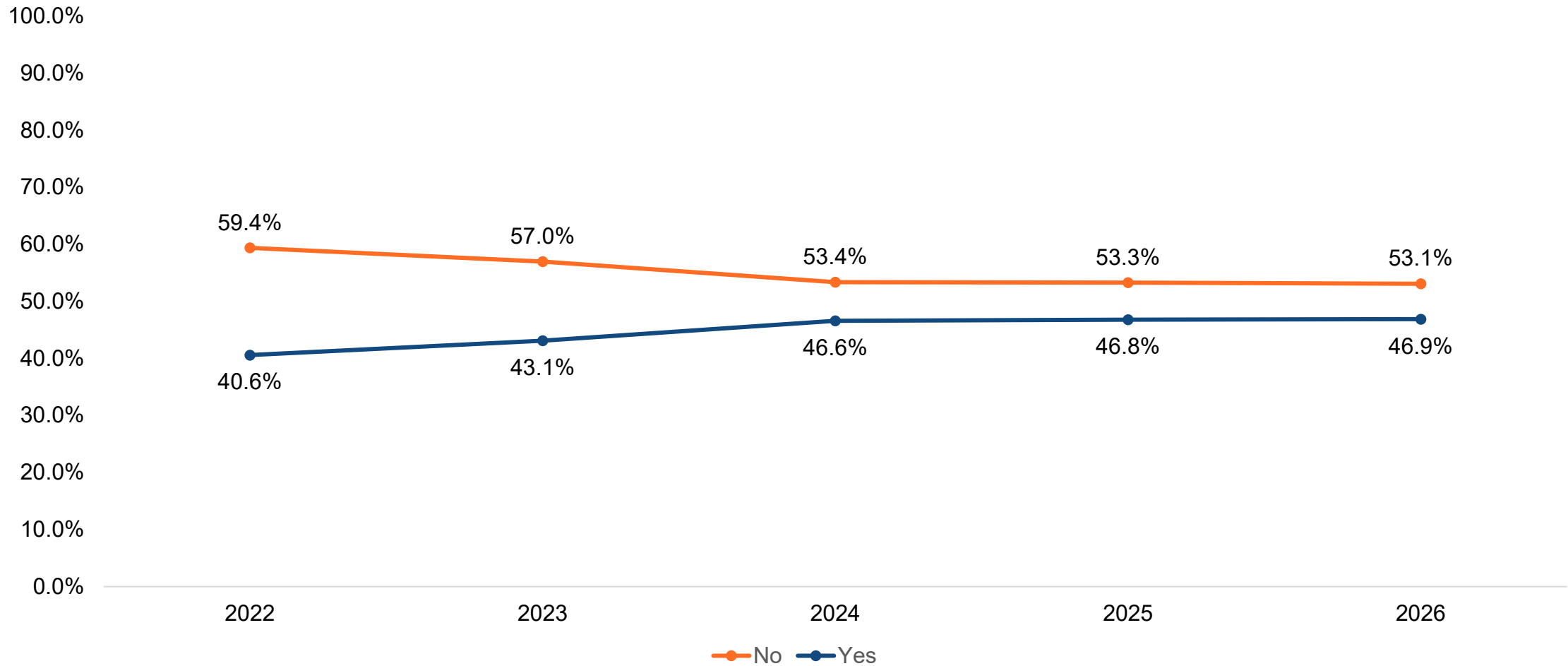
# Age Group of Clark Students, Winter 2022-2026

# First Generation Status of Clark Students, Winter 2022-2026

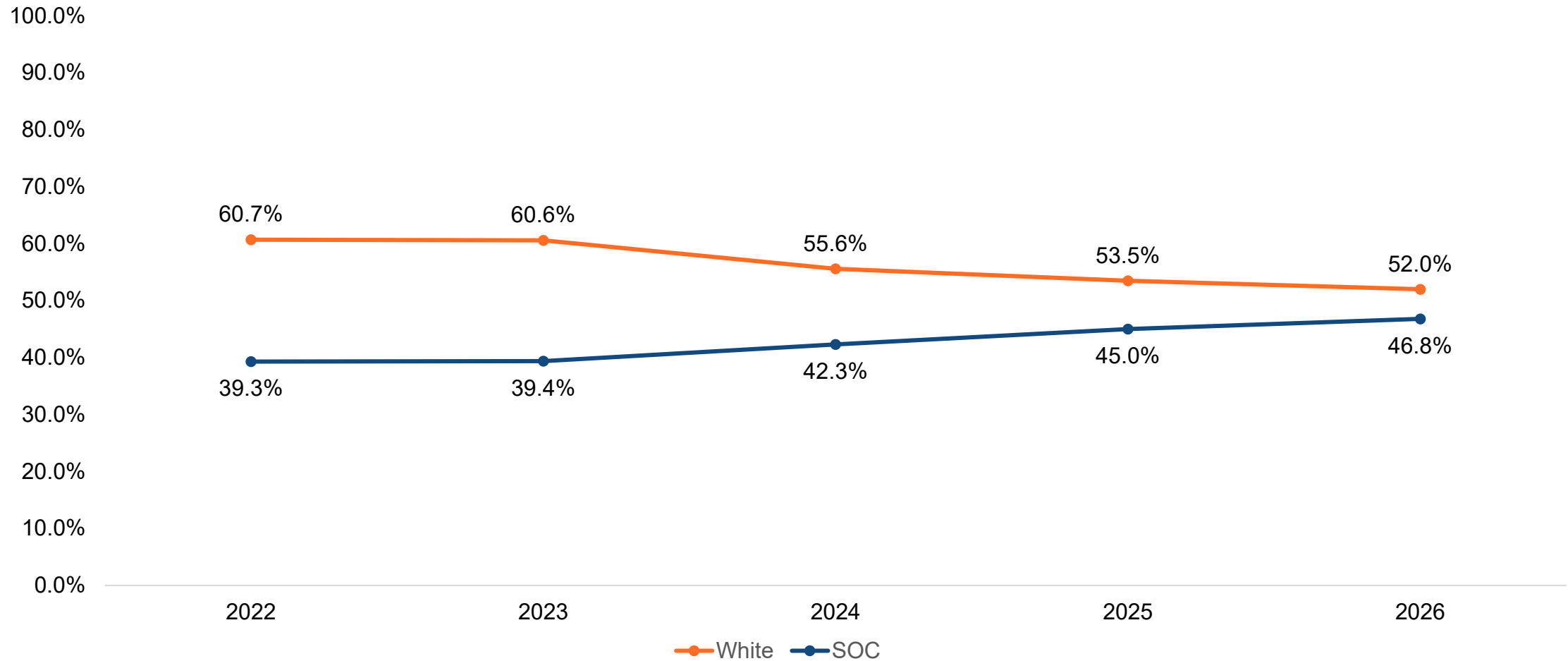

# First Generation Clark Students by Race/Ethnicity, Winter 2022-2026

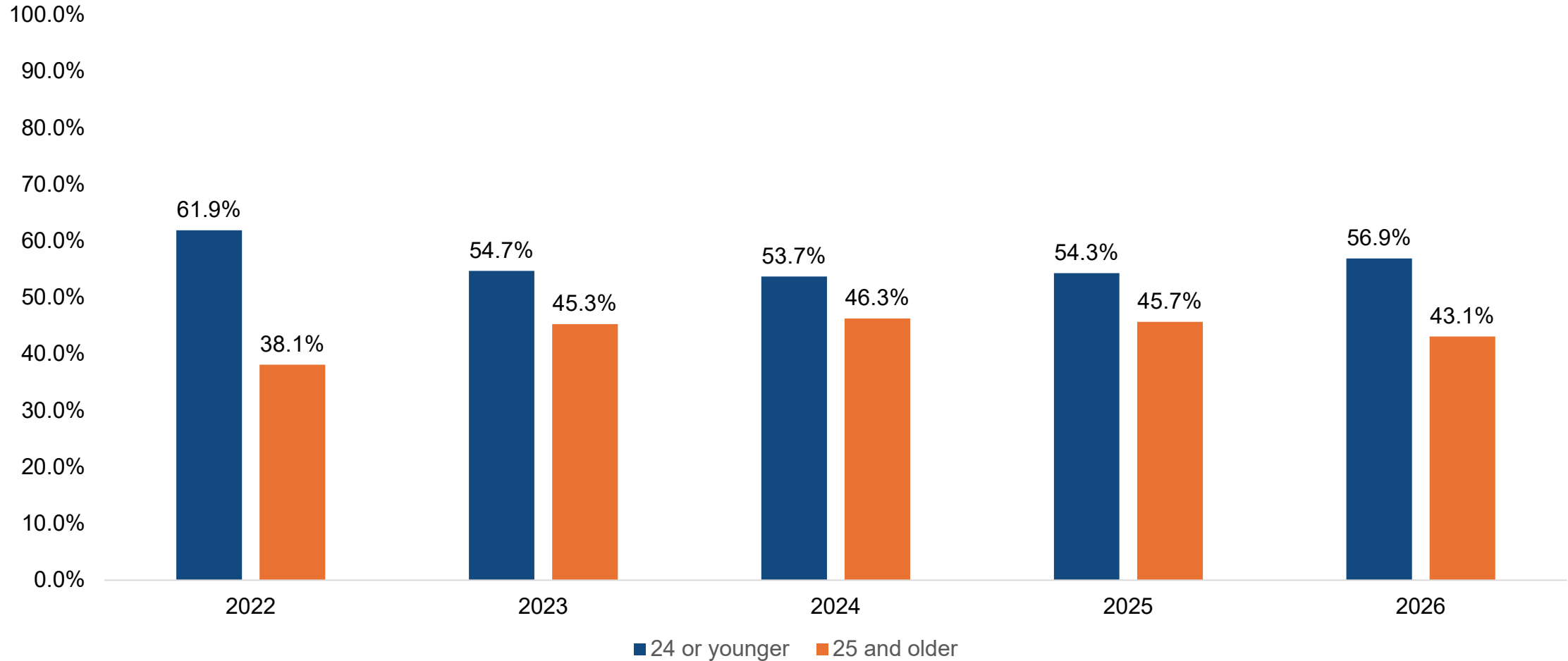

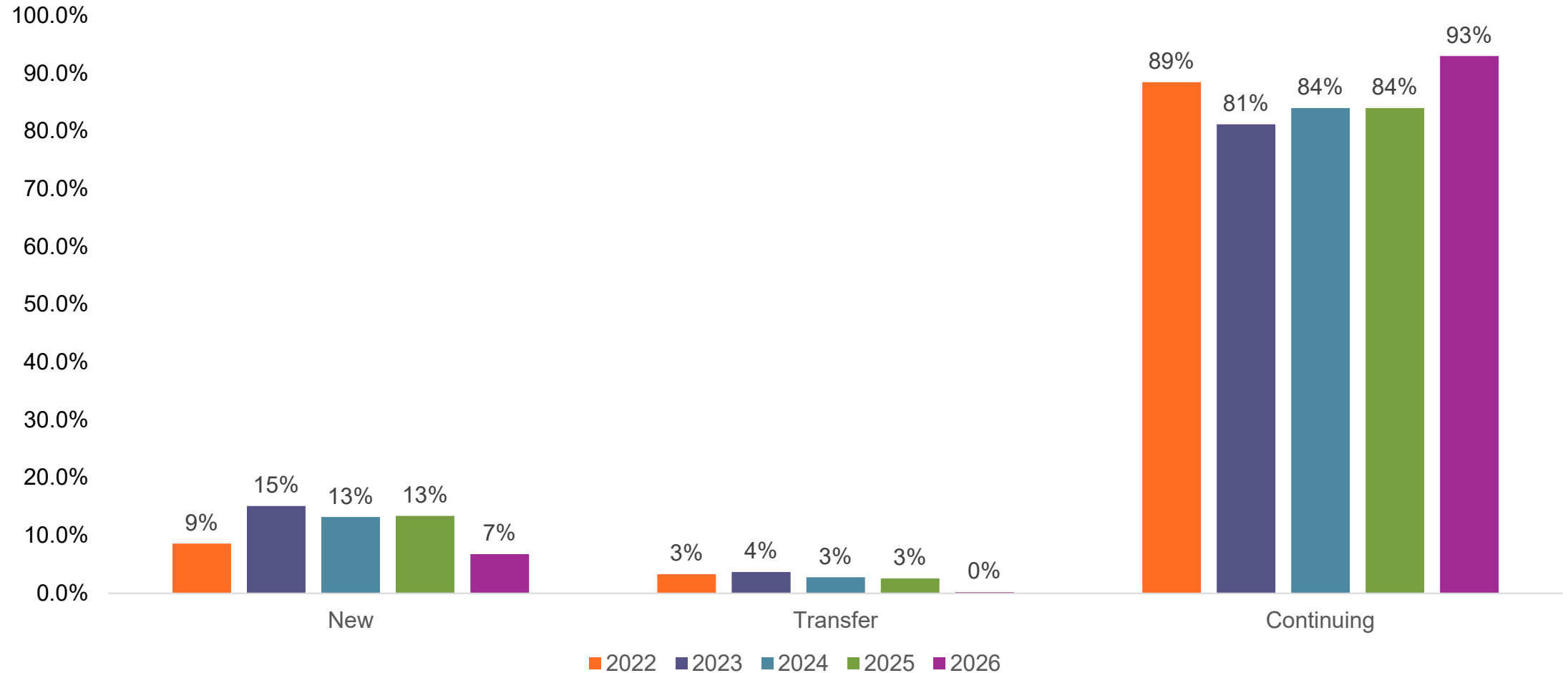

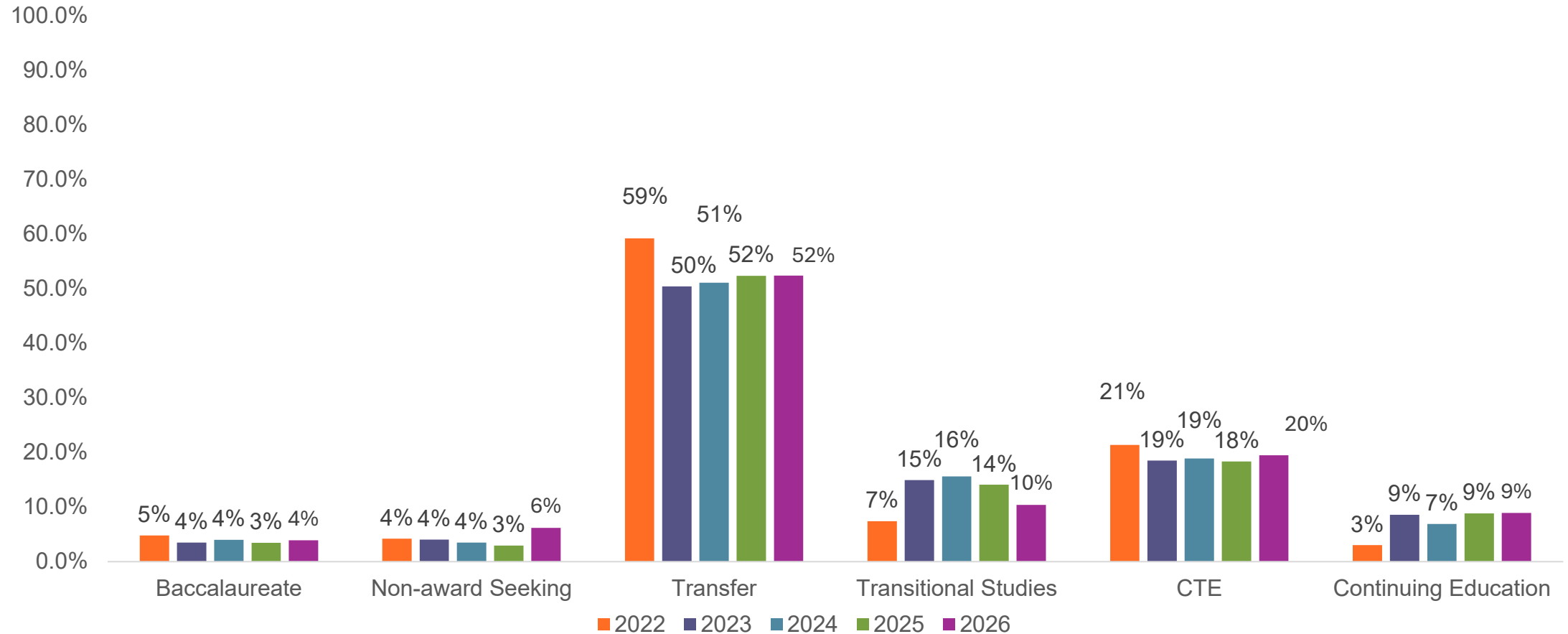


# Clark College Student Status (Headcount), Winter 2022-2026

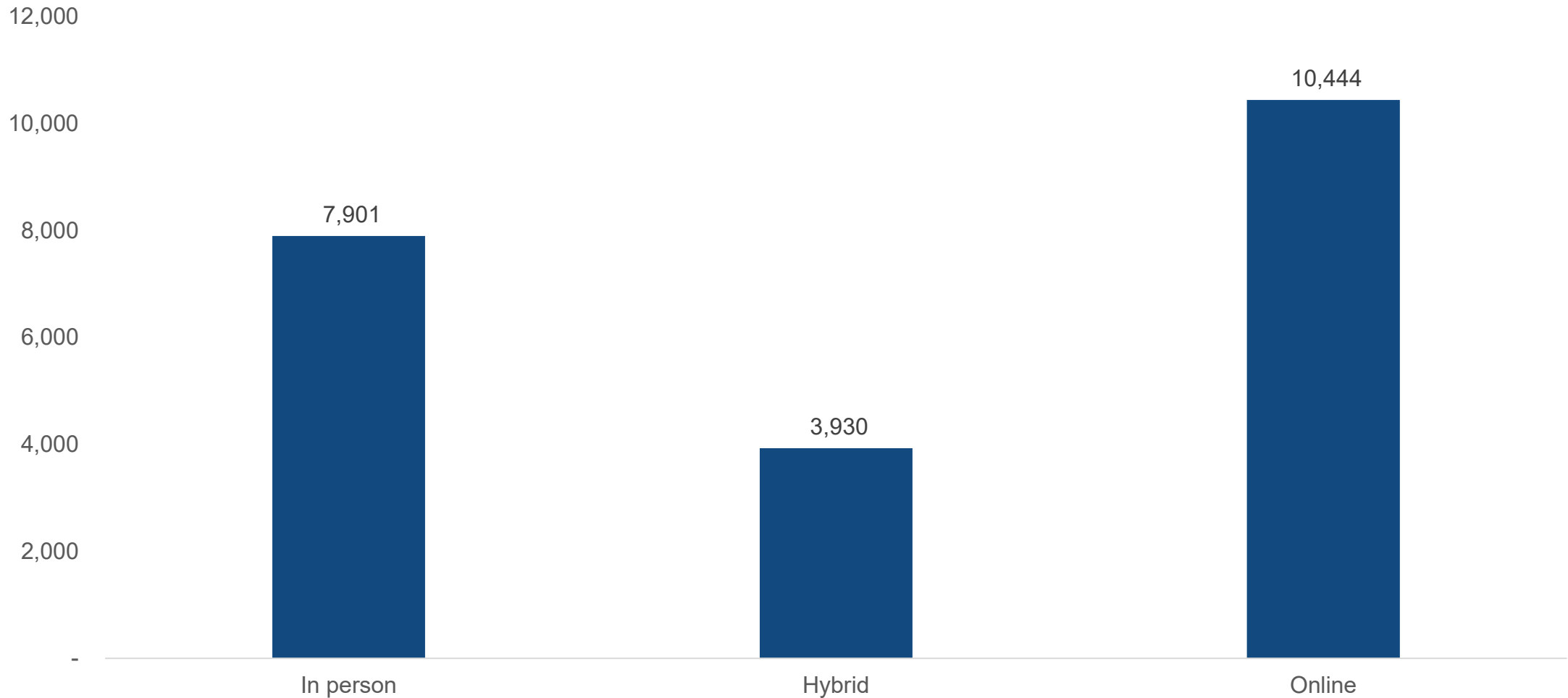
# Program Type of Clark Students, Winter 2022-2026

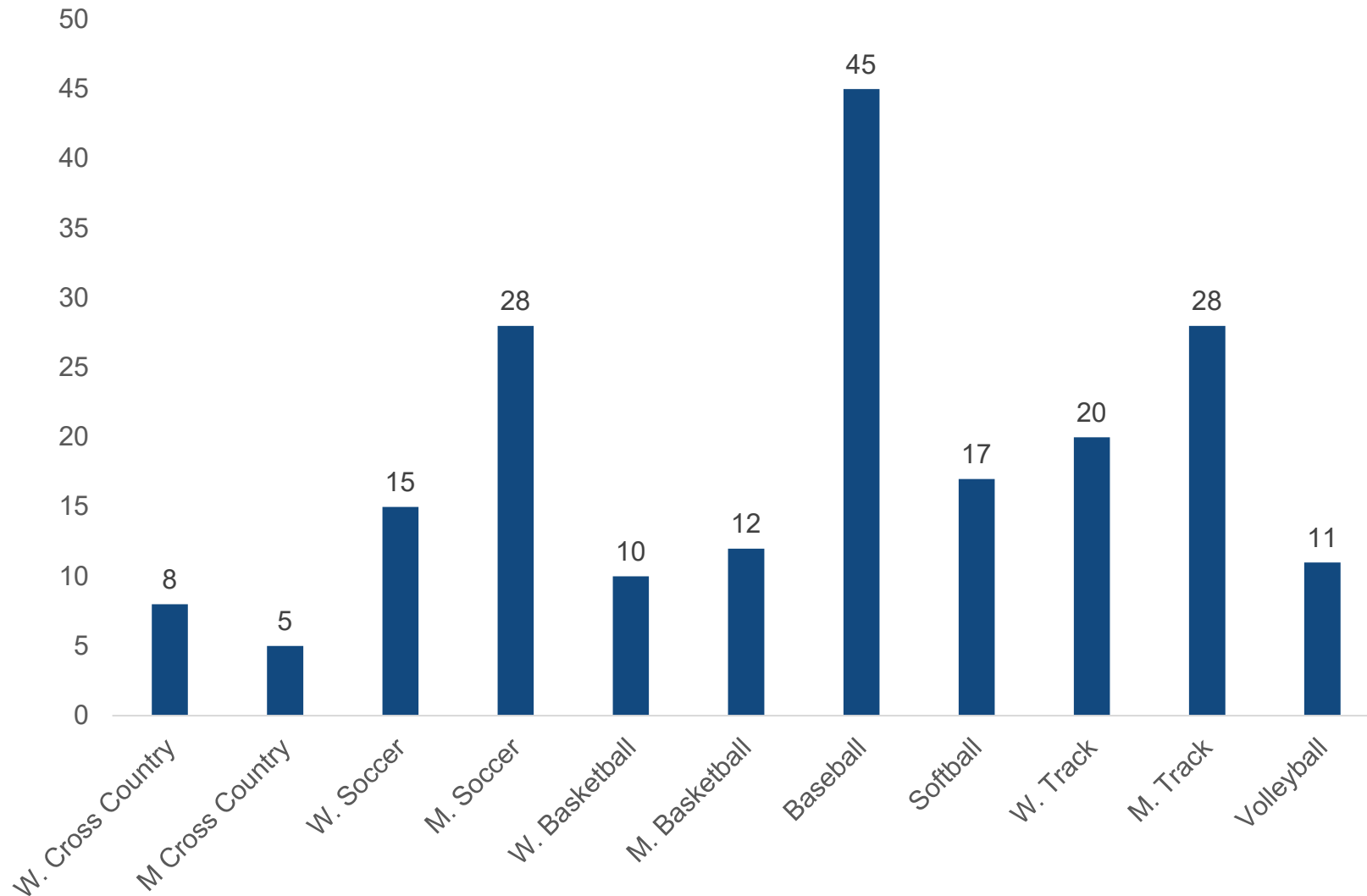
# Disability Access Center (DAC)

  - have approved accommodation plans and are registered for at least one class this term.



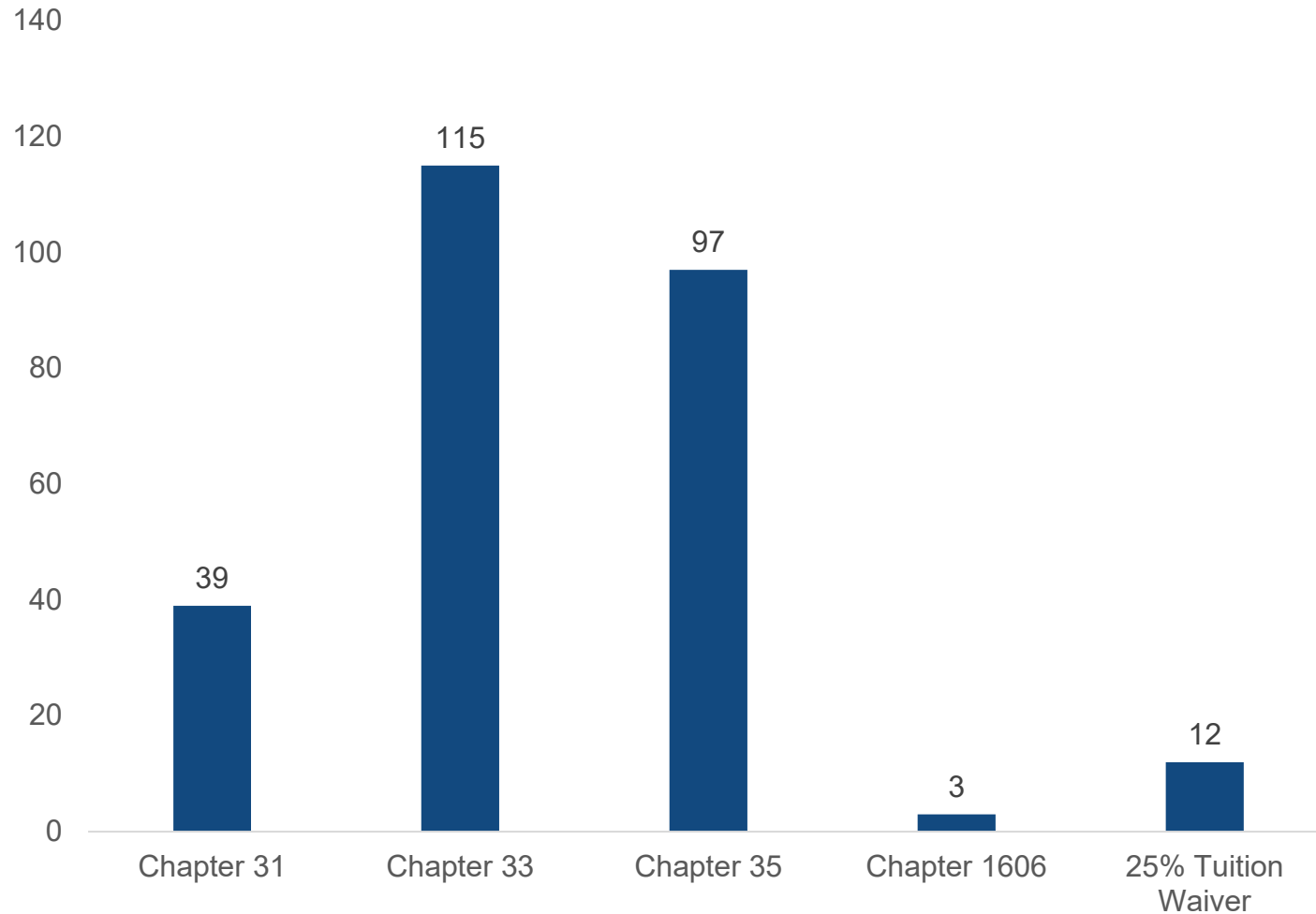

# Number of Students Receiving VA Benefits



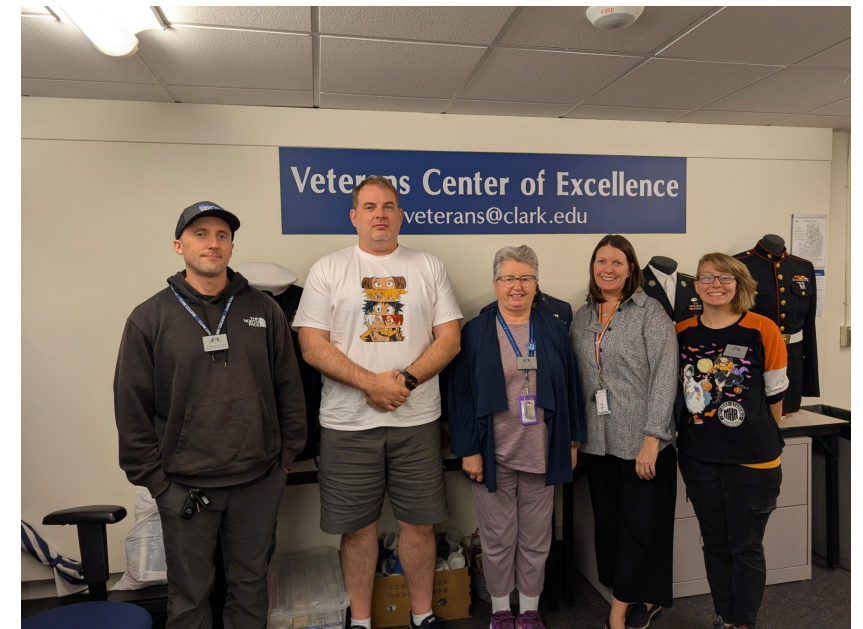

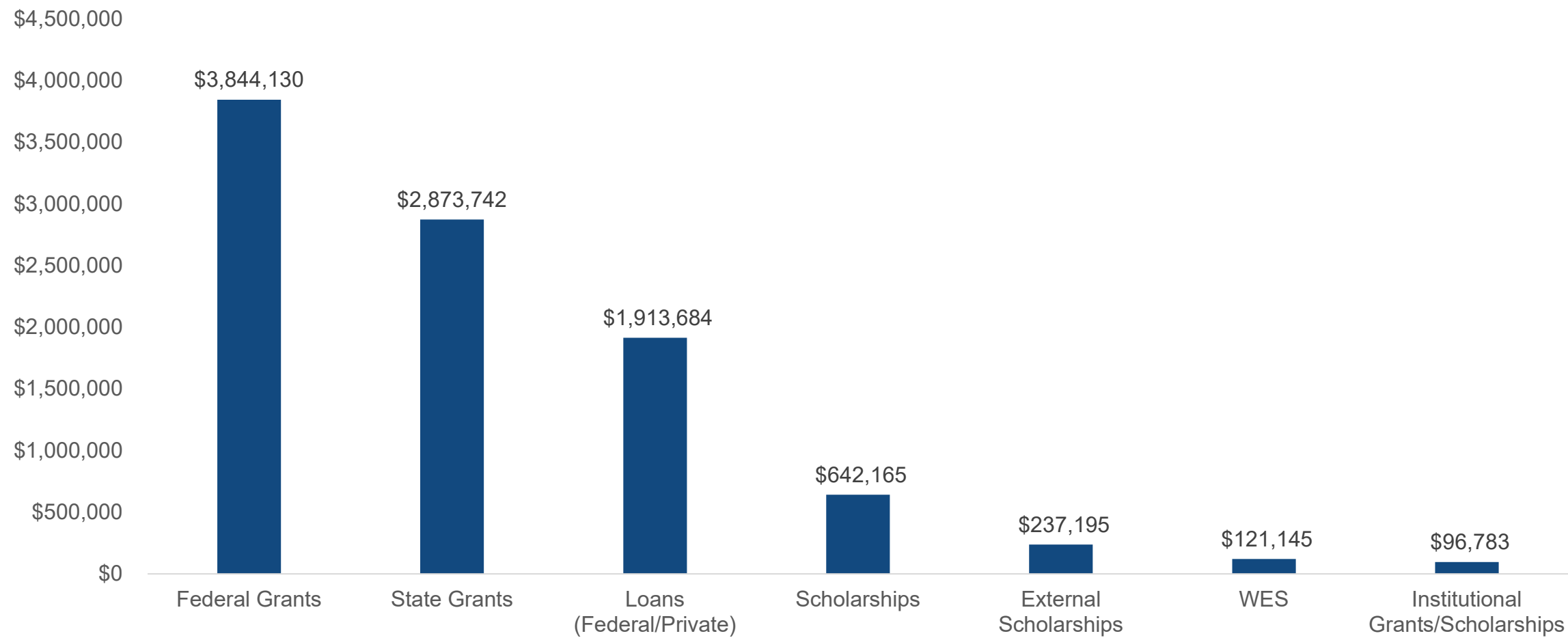
