The following action taken at the Pharmacy Technician Accreditation Commission meeting on May 14, 2025:

**VOTED**

To approve for accreditation the pharmacy technician education and training program at Clark College Pharmacy Technician Training Program, Vancouver, Washington; further,

To grant accreditation for six years (2031), at which time a midterm progress report will be requested to determine continued accreditation.

(Note: The Commission identified that areas of partial compliance 1, 2, 7, and 9 have been resolved to its satisfaction and no further information needs to be provided in these areas on the midterm progress report; all other areas of partial compliance should be addressed.)

The Commission arrived at its decision based on a thorough review of the report of the survey conducted on November 21, 2024, and your facility's response to the survey findings. The ASHP and ACPE Board of Directors reviewed and accepted the Pharmacy Technician Accreditation Commission on June 7, 2025 and June 13, 2025. This pharmacy technician education and training program has been duly accredited by ASHP/ACPE since February 12, 2024. Accreditation is granted subject to the provisions set forth in the ASHP/ACPE Regulations on Accreditation of Pharmacy Technician Education and Training Programs.
