Clark College Area High School Graduates Class of 2007 One Year Follow-up

Executive Summary

Each year, the Office of Planning and Effectiveness compiles a report based on a one year follow-up of high school graduates in the Clark College area. Information for graduates in the Class of 2007 is reported in two groups. Area 1, which makes up about 95% of all the high school students in the Clark College area, includes Battle Ground, Camas, Evergreen, La Center, Ridgefield, Vancouver, Washougal, and Woodland School Districts, and includes for the first time Hockinson. Area 2 includes Glenwood, Klickitat, Lyle, Stevenson-Carson, Trout Lake, White Salmon and Wishram School Districts.

Highlights of Class of 2007

- A total of 5,030 students graduated from high school in the Clark College area in 2007.
 - 4,806 graduates are from Area 1
 - 224 graduates are from Area 2
- ♦ Vancouver, Evergreen, and Battle Ground School District graduates make up 74% of the Clark College area graduates.
- ♦ 56% (2,810) of all Clark College area high school graduates attended college within one year after graduation.
- ♦ 51% of *all graduates attending college* within one year after graduation (1,431 of 2,810) enrolled at Clark College.
- ♦ 28% of *all area high school graduates* (1,431 of 5,030) attended Clark College within one year after graduation.
- Clark College was the number one destination for high school graduates from the area.
- ♦ 79% of graduates attended in-state schools and the remaining 21% attended school outside of Washington state.

Clark College Area High School Graduates Class of 2007 One Year Follow-up

A College Enrollment Study is conducted each year for the Washington State Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) by the Social and Economic Sciences Research Center at Washington State University, in cooperation with the Washington State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) and Washington's public baccalaureate colleges and universities. Information in this report is based on data submitted to OSPI from local school districts and matched to National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) records. Adjustments are made to the high school data based on SBCTC enrollment figures.

A total of 5,030 Clark College area high school graduates in the Class of 2007 are included in this report. This is an increase of 313 graduates from 2006.

4,806 are from the school districts closest to Clark College (those in Clark County and also Woodland, WA) – called Area 1 in this report. This is an increase of 303 graduates. This increase is due, in part, to the graduation of 145 students from Hockinson high school. This is their second graduating class, an increase of 64 over the first year.

An additional 224 graduates are from the school districts in Skamania and Klickitat known as Area 2 in this report, which is an increase of 10 graduates from 2006.

Vancouver, Evergreen, and Battle Ground School District graduates make up 74% of the area graduates.

College After High School

Based on analysis of the records of area high school students, it is estimated that 2,694 students from Area 1 attended college within one year after graduation. An additional 116 from Area 2 attended college, for a total of 2,810 (56%) high school graduates attending college within one year of graduation.


52% of those students who attended college were enrolled in a Washington community or technical college.

College attendance of 2007 high school graduates from the Clark College area was slightly lower than the state of Washington average. 56% of Clark College area graduates attended college within one year of graduation, compared to 59% of high school graduates statewide. 28% of all area high school graduates attended Clark College within their first year of graduation. This is a slight increase from the class of 2006.

51% of all graduates from area high schools who attended college enrolled at Clark College.

Demographics of Graduates Who Attended College

A greater percentage of females than males from Area 1 attended college within one year of high school graduation. The rate of college attendance of high school graduates who attended college within one year of high school graduation was highest for Asian students, and lowest for Native American and Hispanic students. Attendance at college within a year of graduation dropped slightly overall but went up for Black, Hispanic and Native American high school graduates.



Note: the average used for this graph matches the students for whom demographic data was available and is based on actual students matched to NSC data without any attendance estimates.

Colleges Attended

The percentage of high school graduates from the Clark College area who attended a Washington community and technical college was 52%.

Almost all of those Washington two-year students were enrolled at Clark College or Lower Columbia, as documented in the chart below and on the following page. Since students may attend multiple colleges at the same time the following chart counts these students as a one-half (.5) student at both colleges. An additional 24% attended a four-year public school in Washington and 3% attended a private four-year school in-state. A total of 79% attended in-state schools. The remaining 21% attended school outside of Washington State, as seen on the following page. Names of all colleges attended by Area 1 and Area 2 graduates can be found in the Appendix.



Demographics by Type of School Attended

Attendance differences exist primarily between racial/ethnic groups. The graph below is for Area 1 graduates only (96% of the graduates). A high percentage of Asian high school graduates enroll directly in a four-year college. Hispanic students have the lowest four-year participation rate, although it increased slightly in 2007. Black / African American students have the highest percentage of students who attended other two-year schools. Overall college attendance rates for Black / African American students increased more than 10% in 2007, placing them higher than the average. Native American high school graduates also had an increase in the percent attending college, with the increase happening at the four-year schools.



Top Destinations of Area High School Graduates

Clark College was the number one choice for local high school graduates, enrolling over 1,400 students.

Statewide 4% of the Washington class of 2007 attended Clark College. This is comparable to Bellevue which also received 4% of the graduates. These are the largest share of high school graduates attending community colleges. Four-year schools with the highest percentage are Central (4%), Western (6%), Washington State University (7%), and University of Washington at the top of the list (10%).

In addition to Washington public colleges, high school graduates from the Clark College area attended a wide variety of private and out-of-state schools across the nation.
