

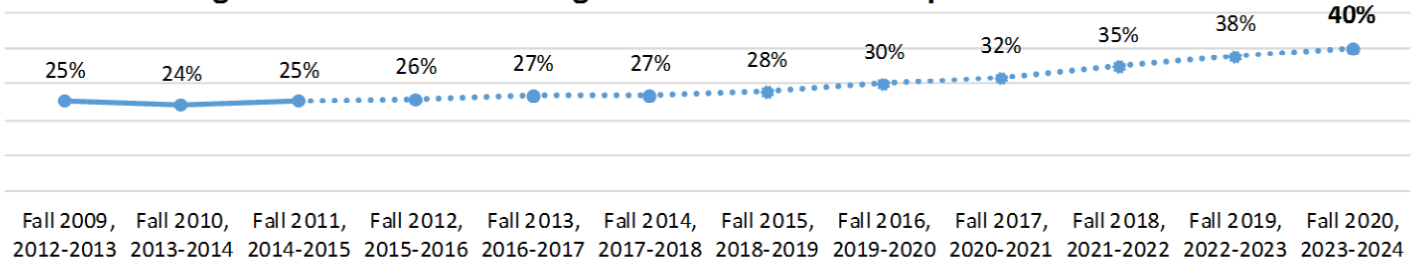

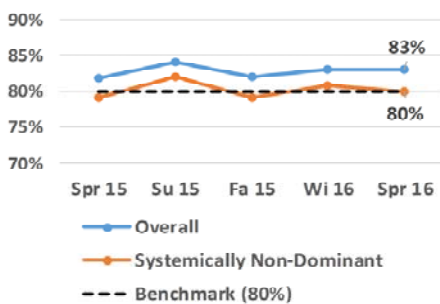

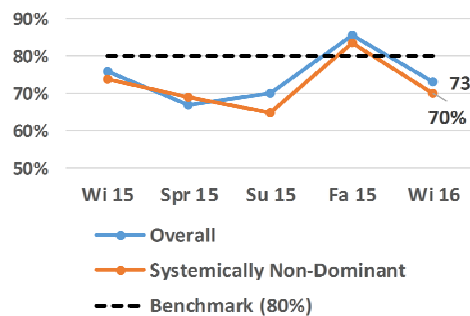
Degree or Certificate-Seeking Full-Time Student Completion Rate Within 3 Years



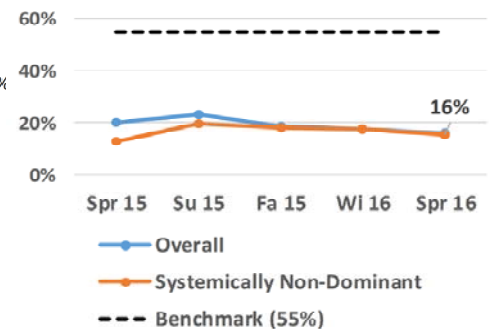
Course Success Rate: Certificate or Degree-Seeking Students

Monthly Highlights

- ◇ Penguin Welcome Days are being offered to new students this summer and include seven (7) sessions specific to completion, including information on: Advising Services, Career Services, Student Success Programs, Career Assessment, eLearning, Student Life & Office of Diversity & Equity.
- ◇ In June, Clark College granted degrees and certificates to approximately 1070 students who completed their program requirements for spring quarter, which is approximately 9% more than spring 2015.
- ◇ During the 2015-16 year we awarded 260 credits through our Credit for Prior Learning Program, which aligns with the goal to implement and institutionalize practices that increase academic performance, retention, and completion. Our goal for the entire academic year was 150 credits.
