

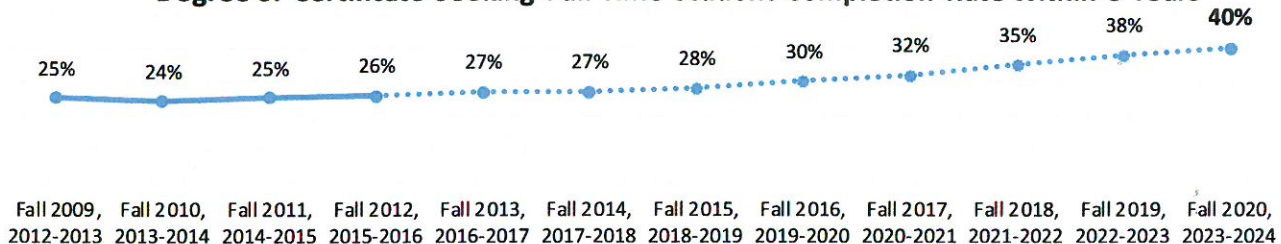

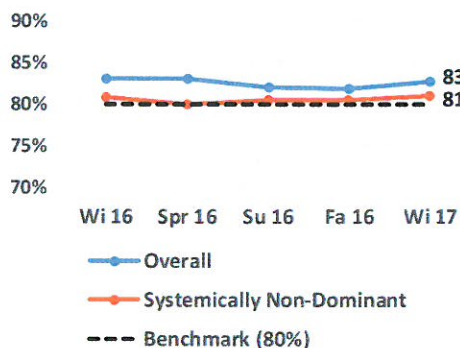

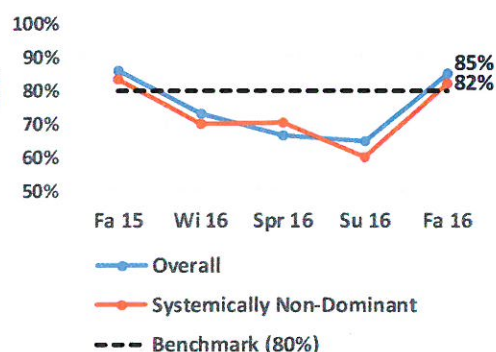
Degree or Certificate-Seeking Full-Time Student Completion Rate Within 3 Years



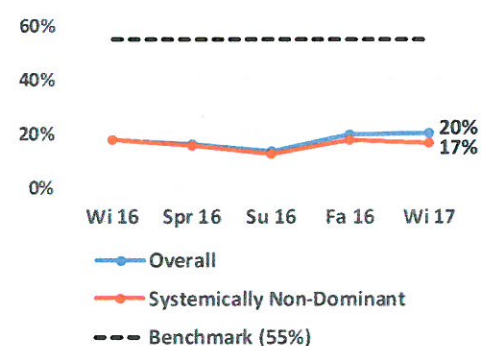
Course Success Rate: Certificate or Degree-Seeking Students

Monthly Highlights

- ◇ The Credential Evaluations office finalized winter 2017 completions with a total of 290 combined degree and certificates awarded.
- ◇ To date, the Credential Evaluations office has received 2,613 graduation applications for 2016-2017.
- ◇ Clark College was invited to participate as a member in the American Association of Community Colleges' Pathways 2.0 Institute through a competitive application process. AACC selected and invited the member colleges based on the college's demonstration of serious commitment to transformational work at scale to improve college completion and equity in student outcomes.
