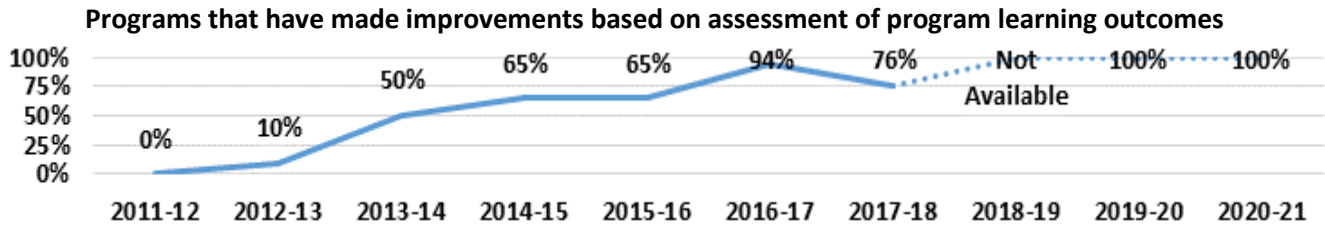

Monthly Highlights

- ◇ After two years of restructuring the medical assisting program, the outcomes are positive. The first annual pinning ceremony for this program took place on August 28th in the GHL student center. At that time, 15 of the 29 students had already been offered a job at the end of their clinical internship (prior to even passing their board exam). Furthermore, one of the student speakers is visually impaired and spoke highly of the program's equity centered inclusive work that has enabled her to achieve a lifetime goal.
