- 1. Register in SERS before June 2025
- 2. Apply to Clark College
- 3. Earn a B or better
- 4. Fill out a request form for transcription by June 30, 2025

Step 1: Register in SERS

The Statewide Enrollment and Reporting System (SERS) is the official CTE Dual Credit registration site for Washington state and is an online tool that helps students register for CTE dual credit classes and track their grades.

SERS is the one-stop for how high schools and colleges communicate grades and course completion.

Students must register in SERS during the school year they are taking the course.

Step 2: Apply to Clark College

To transcribe credit onto a college transcript, students will need to have a Clark College student ID also called a ctcLink ID.

If you have already applied to Clark College in the past

Fill out a request form to have your CTE dual credits transcribed to <u>dualcredit@clark.edu</u> by

June 30th

Clark College will check grades in SERS and apply college credit to the student's Clark transcript. This process takes 4 weeks. You will receive an email when it is complete!
