All interested students meeting the minimum requirements are encouraged to apply for admission to the BAS in Applied Management program. Prior to admission, applicants must have the following:

- An Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree or an Associate of Applied Technology (AAT) degree or higher from an accredited institution/or international equivalent;
- A cumulative 2.0 GPA;
- The courses listed below, completed prior to admission to the BAS program, with a “C” grade or better:
 - ENGL& 101 (5 credits) or equivalent;
 - MATH& 146 – Introduction to Statistics (5 credits) or math equivalent;
 - CMST& 210, 220, or 230 (5 credits) or equivalent;
- A completed BAS in Applied Management application package submitted in person or by email to the Enrollment Services Office (GHL 128). Email: admissions@clark.edu Office hours are available at www.clark.edu/registration
- General Education Completion Requirement – Please note that a minimum of 60 quarter credits (100-level or above) to include ten credits minimum in each of the following categories is required in order to complete the BASAM program: communication studies, quantitative skills, humanities, social science, and natural science as defined by Clark College.
